NOW, THEREFORE, for \$10.00 (US) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to Assignee its entire right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property for the United States and for all foreign countries, including, without limitation, any registrations and applications therefor, any renewals and extensions of the registrations, and all other corresponding rights that are or may be secured under the laws of the United States or any foreign country, now or hereafter in effect, for Assignee's own use and enjoyment, and for the use and enjoyment of Assignee's successors, assigns or other legal representatives, at least as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made, together with all income, royalties or payments due or payable as of the

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Effective Date or thereafter, including, without limitation, all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement or other unauthorized use of the Intellectual Property, with the right to sue for and collect the same in Assignee's own name.

Assignor hereby requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, the Register of Copyrights and the corresponding entity or agency in any applicable foreign country, to record, as applicable, Assignee as the Assignee and owner of the Intellectual Property.

Assignor represents and warrants that: (1) Assignor is the sole and exclusive owner of the entire rights, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property (including the corresponding rights set forth in the above), free and clear of any liens, security interests or other encumbrances of any kind; (2) Assignor has the full right and authority to execute this Assignment and to assign to Assignee the rights assigned herein; and (3) Assignor has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement or other instrument in conflict herewith. Assignor shall indemnify, defend and hold Assignee harmless from and against any liability, claim or other obligation (including but not limited to any attorneys fees, court costs or other expenses) incurred by or made against Assignee resulting from the breach of any of the foregoing representations and warranties.


