### ASSIGNMENT

We, Jay D. Logue, Richard A. Landsman and Timothy T. Sullivan of 3382 Olsen Drive San Jose, California 95117; 631 Worth Lane, Scotts Valley, California 95066; and 4 Morro Vista Lane, Portola Valley, California 94028; respectively, along with Phillip York Goldman, now deceased, have invented a method and apparatus entitled **FEDERATED CHALLENGE CREDIT SYSTEM** hereinafter called the "invention."




Cooperation to the best of our ability in the execution of all lawful documents, the production of evidence, nullification, reissue, extension, or infringement proceedings involving said invention.
