SECTION SEVEN: AMENDMENT(S)

This letter agreement embodies the final and entire agreement of the parties hereto, and supersedes all understandings, written or oral, relating to the subject matter hereof. This assignment agreement may not be modified or amended or any term or provision waived or discharged, except in a written instrument signed by the party against whom such modification, amendment, waiver or discharge is sought.

SECTION EIGHT: MANDATORY ARBITRATION

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this assignment agreement will be resolved only by binding arbitration, conducted by the Judicial Arbitration and Mediation Service (JAMS) (or their successor, and if no successor, then by the American Arbitration Association), in San Francisco County, State of California according to the rules of such service effective as of notice, as amended hereby. Written notice of the demand for arbitration will be served on the other party and filed with the arbitration service. The demand for arbitration will be made within a reasonable time after the dispute has arisen, and in no event will it be made after the date upon which it would have been barred by the terms of this agreement or applicable law. Any arbitrator must be experienced in the subject matter of the arbitration. Arbitration will be completed not later than 180 days following its initiation. In reaching an award, the arbitrator(s) will follow and be bound by substantive California law, as if they were judges sitting in a California court of law.

However, arbitrators will in no manner award punitive damages (or damages calculated by applying a multiplier) or damages for emotional distress. The award will be in writing and will contain findings of fact and conclusion of law and will set forth the nature, amount and manner of calculation of all damages. The award will be final and binding, and judgment may be entered upon it in any court having jurisdiction. This provision has been expressly agreed to by the parties with full understanding that it acts to waive their respective constitutional rights to a trial by judge or jury and their respective rights to punitive or emotional distress damages. The outcome of the arbitration, any award associated with the arbitration and all related communication regarding the arbitration itself shall be entirely confidential. It is expressly understood by Assignee and Inventor that any arbitration proceeding as described above is entirely confidential between the parties.

SECTION NINE: MISCELLANEOUS PROVISION

If any term, provision, covenant or restriction herein is held by a court to be invalid, void or unenforceable or against public policy, the remainder of the terms, provisions and restrictions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected impaired or invalidated. This assignment agreement and any other agreements relating to this assignment agreement shall be interpreted, construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California.
















