WHEREAS, Assignee has a desire to acquire all rights, title, and interest in the Patented Invention.


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:


7. The Inventor hereby yet further agrees to, at the expense of the Assignee:


**CORRECTION DECLARATION REGARDING CORRECTION OF
