

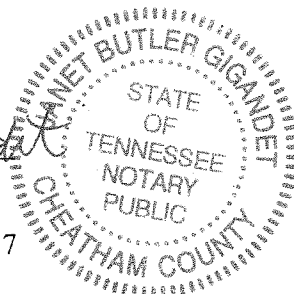



AGREED ORDER APPROVING SALE OF ASSETS

This is before the Court upon the Motion of Michael Gigandet as the Chapter 7 Trustee for the above estate to sell all of the assets of the Debtor by private sale to Quality Scan Tech, LLC (the "Purchaser"). Notice of the proposed sale was provided pursuant to Local Rule 9013-1 on August 27, 2013 and the only objection to the Motion was filed by Pinnacle Bank. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court upon the signatures of counsel for the Trustee, the Debtor and Pinnacle Bank that the parties have reached an agreement for the approval of the sale, it is

ORDERED as follows:

A. The Trustee's proposed sale of all of the Debtor's office equipment, accounts, causes of action and general intangibles, intellectual property listed in the Trustee's Motion and all software related thereto (the "Purchased Assets") is hereby approved to Purchaser for \$5,000 cash to be paid within thirty days of the entry of this Order.

B. The lien of Pinnacle Bank remains in the Purchased Assets to the same extent that it existed prior to the commencement of this Chapter 7 case.

C. The transfer of the Purchased Assets to the Purchaser will be a legal, valid, and effective transfer of the Purchased Assets and, except for the indebtedness and lien of Pinnacle

Bank which is being assumed by Purchaser, will vest the Purchaser with all right, title, and interest of the Debtor and the Trustee to the Purchased Assets free and clear of claims (for purposes of this Sale Order, the term "claim" shall have the meaning ascribed to such term in section 101(5) of the Bankruptcy Code) liens, encumbrances, and other interests of any kind or nature whatsoever.

D. The terms of the sale was proposed and agreed by the Trustee without collusion, in good faith, and from arm's-length bargaining positions. Neither the Purchaser, nor their respective agents, officials, personnel, representatives, and advisors, has engaged in any conduct that would cause or permit the sale to be avoided under section 363(n) of the Bankruptcy Code.

E. The Purchaser is a good faith purchaser under section 363(m) of the Bankruptcy Code and, as such, is entitled to all of the protections afforded thereby.

F. As provided in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(h) and 6006(d), this Order shall not be stayed for fourteen (14) days after its entry, and the Trustee and the Purchaser are authorized to close the sale any time after the entry of the Order.
