ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, Heinrich Jehle, a citizen of Germany; (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNOR"), have invented and own a certain invention entitled HIGH THROUGHPUT POLYMER-BASED MICROARRAY SLIDE (Attorney Docket No. GRE-105us), for which application for Letters Patent of the United States of America was filed on January 29, 2006;


Patent or any legal equivalent thereof to said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, in accordance with this Assignment.
