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## RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENT COLLATERAL

This **RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENT COLLATERAL** (this “Release”) is made as of February 12, 2014 (“Effective Date”) by Wells Fargo Capital Finance, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (formerly known as Wells Fargo Foothill, LLC), in its capacity as agent for the Lender Group and the Bank Product Providers, as such terms are defined in the below defined Credit Agreement (in such capacity, “Agent”), in favor of **API HEALTHCARE CORPORATION**, a Wisconsin corporation (formerly known as API Software, Inc.) (“Grantor”).

**WHEREAS**, reference is made to that certain Amended and Restated Credit Agreement dated as of February 8, 2012 (as amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Credit Agreement”), by and among the lenders identified on the signature pages thereof (such lenders, together with their respective successors and permitted assigns, are referred to hereinafter each individually as a “Lender” and collectively as the “Lenders”), **WELLS FARGO CAPITAL FINANCE, LLC**, a Delaware limited liability company, as the administrative agent for the Lenders (in such capacity, together with its successors and assigns in such capacity, “Agent”, and together with the Lenders, the “Lender Group”), co-lead arranger, and joint bookrunner, **GOLUB CAPITAL, LLC**, a Delaware limited liability company, as syndication agent, co-lead arranger and joint bookrunner, **CAPITAL ONE, N.A.**, a national banking association, as documentation agent and a Lender, **API HEALTHCARE HOLDING CORPORATION**, a Delaware corporation, **CLEARVIEW STAFFING SOFTWARE, INC.**, a Texas corporation, **CONCERRO, INC.**, a California corporation, **RES-Q HEALTHCARE SYSTEMS, INC.**, a California corporation, and Grantor;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the terms and conditions of that certain Patent Security Agreement dated as of November 20, 2008 (as amended, restated, supplemented, or otherwise modified from time to time, the “Patent Security Agreement”), by and between Grantor and Agent, Grantor granted to Agent a security interest in and to all of Grantor’s right, title and interest in and to the Patent Collateral (as such term is defined in the Patent Security Agreement);

**WHEREAS**, the Patent Security Agreement was initially recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on November 20, 2008 at Reel 021868, Frame 0759 as corrected on February 10, 2009 via recordation at Reel 022238, Frame 0357; and

**WHEREAS**, Agent now desires to release its security interest in the Patent Collateral, including, without limitation, the patents listed on Schedule 1 hereto.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Agent hereby covenants and agrees as follows:



Without representation or warranty of any kind or nature, Agent hereby terminates, releases, and discharges its security interest in the Patent Collateral granted pursuant to the Patent Security Agreement, and reassigns to Grantor all right, title, and interest of Agent in the Patent Collateral pursuant to the Patent Security Agreement.

2. Agent hereby agrees to duly execute, acknowledge, procure and deliver any further documents and to do such other acts, in each case at Grantor’s expense, as may be reasonably necessary to effect the release of the security interest in the Patent Collateral contemplated hereby.
