

Assignors hereby irrevocably appoint the President of Assignee, or the President's designee, as Assignors' attorney-in-fact with authority to execute for Assignors and on Assignors' behalf any and all assignments, applications, or other instruments and documents required to be executed by Assignors pursuant to this Agreement, if Assignors is unwilling or unable to execute same. Nothing contained in this assignment obligates the Assignee to file a patent application, either provisional or non-provisional, or any divisionals, continuations, continuations in part, extensions, renewals, and reissues thereof, or to continue prosecution of any such filings. Assignors hereby acknowledge

that the decision whether or not to file or continue prosecution of any of the foregoing shall be within Assignee's sole discretion.

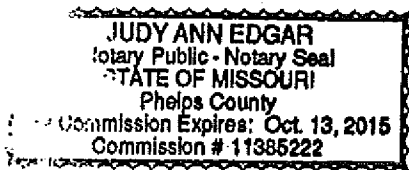



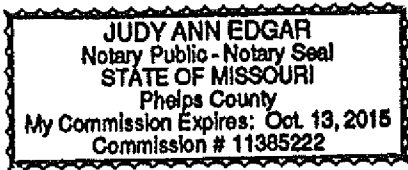
