ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

This Assignment of Patents ("**Assignment**") effective as of December 9, 2013, is entered into by and between KASELCO, LLC, a Texas limited liability company ("**Assignor**"), and BAKERCORP, a Delaware corporation ("**Assignee**").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the owner of those certain patents and patent applications set forth in the attached Schedule A (the "**Patents**"); and

WHEREAS, reference is made to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of December 9, 2013 (the "**Purchase Agreement**"), by and among Assignee and Assignor, pursuant to which Assignee has purchased from Assignor certain assets associated with Assignor's business; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the Purchase Agreement and the transactions contemplated thereby, Assignor desires to assign to Assignee, and Assignee desires to acquire from Assignor, all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in and to the Patents.

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound hereby, Assignor and Assignee hereby agree as follows:

1. Conveyance and Acceptance. Assignor hereby assigns, transfers, and conveys to Assignee the Patents along with (i) any and all patents or patent applications that claim priority to the Patents, including continuations, divisions, continuations-in-part, reissues and reexaminations, Inter Partes Review (IPR) certificates and Post-Grant Review (PGR) certificates thereof; (ii) all foreign patents, patent applications, and counterparts relating to any of the foregoing including, without limitation, certificates of invention, utility models, industrial design protection, design patent protection, and other equivalent government grants or issuances, all inventions, invention disclosures, discoveries, know how, show how, trade secrets, design rights, trade dress, get up, copyrights, and ideas described in any of the foregoing, and all rights to collect royalties and other payments under or on account of any of the Patents and/or any item in any of the foregoing (collectively, the "**Patent Rights**") and (iii) all rights of action pertaining to the Patents, including without limitation the right to sue and recover for past, present, and future infringement thereof including without limitation rights to damages, profits, attorneys' fees, and injunctive relief, the right to secure registration of the Patent Rights and of this Assignment, the right to initiate other proceedings before all government, judicial and administrative bodies with respect to the Patent Rights, and the right to claim priority derived from said Patents under the Patent Laws, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable, file foreign counterparts, and make applications for reissue, IPR, PGR, reexamination and any other proceeding or filing impacting the Patent Rights.

2. Recordation and Further Actions. Assignor authorizes the Commissioner for Patents and any other governmental officials to record and register this Assignment upon request by Assignee. Assignor will, at the reasonable request of Assignee and without demanding any further consideration therefore, do all things necessary, proper, or advisable, including without limitation, the execution, acknowledgment, and recordation of specific assignments, oaths, declarations, and other documents to assist Assignee in obtaining, perfecting, sustaining, and/or enforcing the Patent Rights. Such assistance will include providing and obtaining from respective inventors still employed by an affiliate of Assignor, prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, powers of attorney, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance reasonably necessary for filing patent applications, complying with any duty of disclosure, and conducting prosecution, reexamination, reissue, interference or other priority proceedings, opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, public use proceedings, infringement or other court or administrative actions and the like with respect to the Patent Rights. If an inventor is not still employed by an affiliate of Assignor, Assignor will assist Assignee in obtaining from the inventor any required facts, documents, testimony, executions, and other assistance reasonably necessary with respect to the Patent Rights. Any costs in obtaining assistance from an uncooperative non-employee inventor will be negotiated between the Assignee and the Assignor at the time.

3. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original (including facsimile copies), but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.


