FIRST SUPPLEMENT TO INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY SECURITY AGREEMENT

This Supplement to Intellectual Property Security Agreement (this "Supplement") is made as of the 26th day of March, 2014 by XRS Corporation, a Minnesota corporation formerly known as Xata Corporation (the "Grantor"), in favor of Silicon Valley Bank (the "Grantee").

WHEREAS, the Grantor executed and delivered an Intellectual Property Security Agreement dated February 24, 2012 and recorded with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office on February 28, 2012 at Reel 027775, Frame 0968, as amended on October 17, 2012 at Reel 029142, Frame 0430 (as maybe further amended from time to time hereinafter, the "Grant") in favor of the Grantee, pursuant to which the Grantors pledged, assigned and granted a security interest in certain Intellectual Property Collateral (as defined therein); and

WHEREAS, the Grantor has developed additional Patents and desires to hereby confirm the pledge of, and the grant of a security interest in, such additional Patents in favor of the Grantee.


NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and benefits to be derived herefrom, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. Definitions. All capitalized terms herein and not otherwise defined shall have the same meaning herein as in the Grant.
2. Supplement to Exhibit B. Exhibit B to the Grant is hereby supplemented, but not replaced, by Schedule B-1 annexed hereto.
3. Miscellaneous:
 - a. Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the Grant remain in full force and effect. The Grantors hereby ratify, confirm and reaffirm all of the representations, warranties and covenants contained therein.
 - b. This Supplement covers the entire understanding of the parties with respect to the matters set forth herein and supersedes all prior discussions and negotiations hereon.
