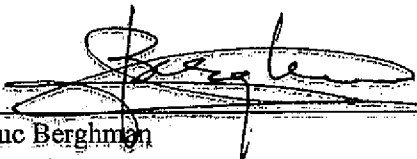
(4) in and to all applications filed under International Conventions on the invention or claiming priority to the PCT patent application or provisional application.

The Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States is hereby authorized and requested to issue said United States patent or patents to Assignee.

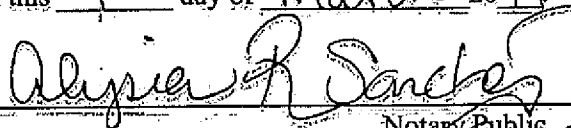
