(i) all know-how, including all information, including without limitation

trade secrets, whether or not patentable, relating to, used in, or useful in connection with the Patent Rights, or any methods or devices which are claimed to result in and be useful in connection with the Patent Rights; and

(j) all rights to collect royalties and other payments under or on account of the Patents and/or any item in any of the foregoing categories (a) through (i); [(a)-(j) collectively referred to as the "Patent Rights".]

Assignor hereby authorizes the respective patent office or governmental agency in each jurisdiction to issue any and all patents, certificates of invention, utility models or other governmental grants or issuances that may be granted upon any of the Patent Rights in the name of Assignee, as the assignee to the entire interest therein.

Assignor warrants that: (i) Assignor is the legal owner of all right, title and interest in the Patents and Patent Rights; (ii) that such Patents and Patent Rights have not been previously licensed, pledged, assigned, or encumbered; and (iii) that this Assignment does not infringe on the rights of any person.

Assignor authorizes the United States Patent and Trademark Office to issue any Patents and Patent Rights to Assignee. The right, title and interest is to be held and enjoyed by Assignee and Assignee's successors and assigns as fully and exclusively as it would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this assignment not been made.

Assignor agrees to cooperate with Assignee and to execute and deliver all papers, instruments and assignments as may be necessary to vest all right, title and interest in and to the intellectual property rights to the Patents and Patent Rights in Assignor. Assignor further agrees to testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers and applications and make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid Assignee to obtain and enforce proper protection for the Patents and Patent Rights in all countries.

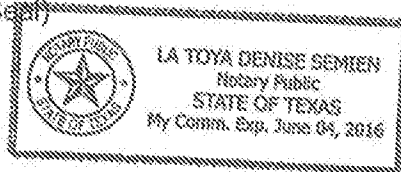
