1. The undersigned, Patrick La Riviere is an inventor for the invention as disclosed in the above referenced patent application (13/960,821) and is also an employee of the University of Chicago, Chicago, IL.
2. The undersigned has been asked to sign an assignment form with intent that the inventors assign their entire patent rights associated with the invention and their improvements to the designated assignees. For the above intent, the assignment form was prepared by an attorney, Ken Yoshida of Yoshida & Associates, LLC Philadelphia, PA to assign the invention rights from the inventor assignors including David Rigie, Patrick La Riviere, Adam Petschke and Yuxing Chang to the applicant assignees including The University of Chicago and Toshiba Medical Systems Corporation.
3. The undersigned had an erroneous belief that each of the above inventors has authority to assign his invention. The undersigned executed the assignment form on June 27, 2013, and an executed copy of the assignment form is attached to the Affidavit.
4. The executed copy of the assignment form was recorded by Ken Yoshida at the assignment branch of the USPTO on August 27, 2013 for perfection. A copy of Notice of Recordation of Assignment Document is attached to the Affidavit.
5. After perfection of the assignment form at the USPTO, the undersigned was notified by the University of Chicago of the lack of the authority to sign the assignment form. According to the representative, as a condition of working for the University, the undersigned had signed the University employment agreement which clearly addresses their rights associated with intellectual property. As a result of the agreement, the undersigned has already assigned his rights in the above referenced patent application to the University of Chicago.
6. The undersigned was not aware of the University employment agreement at the time of execution of the assignment form so that he could not execute the assignment form that Ken Yoshida had prepared to assign his rights to Toshiba Medical Systems Corporation.
7. In summary, the undersigned believes that the assignment form was erroneously signed by him and improperly recorded at the USPTO. The undersigned also believes that the recorded assignment is not in force.


