THIS Patent Assignment is made as of May 1, 2014, by Donald E. Skaggs, an individual of the United States, and Donald R. Skaggs, an individual of the United States (collectively, "Assignors"), to SLMP, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, d/b/a StatLab Medical Products ("Assignee").

This assignment expressly grants Assignee all rights in the Patent and Patent Rights as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignors.


Upon said consideration, each of the Assignors hereby covenants and agrees with Assignee, its successors and assigns, that it will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with the rights granted hereunder, and that Assignors and their successors and assigns shall, at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of Assignee, its successors and assigns, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as Assignee, or its successors or assigns, may deem necessary or desirable to perfect Assignee's enjoyment of this grant.

This Patent Assignment may be executed in one or two counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be deemed an original, and both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
