

On this day came on to be heard the Application filed herein by Phyllis Ann Jennings on February 21, 2014, for the probate of the Will of Charles Edward Jennings, hereinafter called "Decedent", for an independent administration pursuant to Section 401.002(b) of the Texas Estates Code, and for the issuance of Letters of Independent Administration *With Will Annexed*

The Court, after having heard and considered the evidence, finds that legal notices of the filing of said Application have been issued and posted in the manner and for the length of time required by law, and no one came to contest same; and it further appearing that said Will was executed on April 5, 2007 with the formalities and solemnities and under the circumstances required by law to make it a valid Will, was not self-proved, but it was proved from the sworn testimony in open court of two persons familiar with the handwriting of Decedent; that on the date said Will was made Decedent had attained the age of eighteen (18) years and was of sound mind; that such Will has not been revoked or modified by Decedent; that Decedent died at Tomball Regional Medical Center, Harris County, Texas on February 13, 2014; that this Court has jurisdiction and venue over the estate because Decedent was domiciled in Texas and had a fixed place of residence in Harris County, Texas at the time of his death; that four years have not elapsed since the death of Decedent or prior to the said Application; that no state, governmental

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agency of the state, nor charitable organization is named by the Will as a devisee; that Decedent's Will failed to name an Executor; and although the Will fails to provide for an independent administration, the sole distributee has agreed on the advisability of having an independent administration; that a necessity exists for the administration of this estate; that it is advisable and in the best interests of the estate of the Decedent that Phyllis Ann Jennings be appointed to serve as Independent Administratrix ^{With Will Annexed} under the provisions of Section 401.002(b) of the Texas Estates Code, and that no other action should be had in this Court in relation to the settlement of the Decedent's estate than the return of an inventory, appraisal and list of claims of such estate, and that Phyllis Ann Jennings would not be disqualified by law from serving as such or from accepting Letters of Administration. ^{Independent} ^{With Will Annexed}

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED by the Court that said Will is hereby proved and established and admitted to probate and recorded as the **LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT** of Charles Edward Jennings, that an independent administration of the Estate of Charles Edward Jennings is granted and that Phyllis Ann Jennings be, and is hereby appointed Independent Administratrix ^{With Will Annexed} of said Will and Estate without bond.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Court that Letters of Administration upon the Will and Estate of Charles Edward Jennings be and the same are hereby granted, that the Clerk shall issue said Letters of Independent Administration ^{With Will Annexed} to Phyllis Ann Jennings, as Independent Administratrix, when qualified according to law, and that no other action shall be had in this Court other than the return of an Inventory, Appraisal and List of Claims as required by law. No interested person has filed an application for the appointment of appraisers, and appointment of appraisers by the Court is waived.
