Kasugai-shi, Aichi 486-0808 JAPAN, which is also desirous of acquiring an interest therein;

AND WHEREAS, for sake of clarity, **KANAZAWA INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, KANAZAWA MEDICAL UNIVERSITY and TOKAI MEDICAL PRODUCTS, INC.** (hereinafter jointly named "Assignees") will jointly own the above-referenced invention and patent applications.
