WHEREAS, Claude Lebel, hereinafter called the "Assignor", made the invention described in French application 1161294 filed December 7, 2011; PCT Application No. PCT/FR2012/052825 filed December 6, 2012, and in United States patent application titled Assembly for Transporting Liquid via Pipes and Associated Floating Structure, filed on June 9, 2014 and assigned Application No. 14/363,924;

The Assignor hereby sells, assigns, and transfers the entire right, title and interest to the Assignee as of the day of filing the application identified above.
