Assignor further authorizes the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office to record the Patent and title thereto as the property of Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.

Assignor hereby covenants that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this assignment and the transfer to Assignee of good and marketable title in and to the Patent, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances of any nature.


Assignor further agrees to execute such further documents as may be reasonably required to record Assignee as the owner of the Patent, solely at the cost of Assignee.
