

IP ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT


This IP Assignment Agreement (the "Agreement") is made and entered into effective as of October 10, 2014 (the "Effective Date") by and among (i) ALTIRA TECHNOLOGY FUND V L.P. ("Assignee"), (ii) ECO POWER SOLUTIONS (USA) CORPORATION ("Assignor"), (iii) Eco Power Solutions Corporation ("Eco Canada"), (iv) Gencon Capital Resources Inc. ("Gencon"), (v) E-Legal Management Corporation ("E-Legal" and together with Gencon, the "Stockholders" and each individually, a "Stockholder").

WHEREAS, Assignor currently has certain property rights with respect to the Property (as defined below); and



WHEREAS, Assignor desires to assign to Assignee the Property in full satisfaction of certain obligations owed by Assignor to Assignee and Assignee desires to accept such assignment of the property in satisfaction thereof; and

WHEREAS all parties hereto consent to the assignment herein to the Assignee; and




I. RECITALS. The recitals as set forth herein are true and incorporated herein by reference.

2. **ASSIGNMENT.** Assignor hereby irrevocably and unconditionally assigns, sells, transfers and conveys to the Assignee all right, title and interest, on a worldwide basis, in and to the technology and materials described in Exhibit A (Description of Property) attached hereto and all Intellectual Property Rights owned by Assignor on the date hereof and related thereto (collectively, the "Property"). As used herein, "Intellectual Property Rights" means all past, present, and future rights of the following types, which may exist or be created under the laws of any jurisdiction in the world: (a) rights associated with works of authorship, including exclusive exploitation rights, copyrights, moral rights, and mask work rights; (b) trademark and trade name rights and similar rights (and associated goodwill); (c) trade secret rights; (d) patent and industrial property rights; (e) other proprietary rights in technology and works of authorship of every kind and nature; and (f) rights in or relating to registrations, renewals, extensions, combinations, continuations, divisions, and reissues of, and applications for, any of the rights referred to in clauses (a) through (e) of this sentence. If Assignor has any Intellectual Property Right to the Property that cannot be assigned to Assignee by Assignor, Assignor unconditionally and irrevocably grants to Assignee during the term of such rights, an exclusive, even as to Assignor, irrevocable, perpetual, worldwide, fully paid and royalty-free license, with rights to sublicense through multiple levels of sublicensees, to reproduce, make derivative works of, distribute, publicly perform and publicly display in any form or medium, whether now known or later developed, make, use, sell, import, offer for sale and exercise any and all such rights. If Assignor has any Intellectual Property Right to the Property that cannot be assigned or licensed to Assignee, Assignor unconditionally and irrevocably waives the enforcement of such right, and all claims and causes of action of any kind against Assignee or related to Assignee's customers, licensees and their customers, with respect to such right, and agrees, at Assignee's request and expense, to consent to and join in any action to enforce such right. Assignor hereby acknowledges that Assignor retains no right to use the Property or and agrees not to challenge, or assist any other person to challenge, the validity of the Assignee's ownership of the Property. Assignor agrees to deliver to the Assignee upon execution of this Agreement any and all tangible manifestation of the Property.

3. **ASSISTANCE.** Upon each request by the Assignee, without additional consideration, Assignor agrees to promptly execute documents, testify and take other acts at the Assignee's expense as the Assignee may deem necessary or desirable to procure, maintain, perfect, and enforce the full benefits, enjoyment, rights, title and interest, on a worldwide basis of the Property assigned hereunder, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, renewal, or reissued utility and design patents, copyrights, mask works, trademarks, trade secrets, and all other technology and Intellectual Property Rights throughout the world related to any of the Property, in the Assignee's name and for its benefit. If the Assignee is unable for any reason, after reasonable effort, to secure Assignor's signature on any document needed in connection with the actions specified herein, Assignor hereby irrevocably designates and appoints the Assignee and its duly authorized officers and agents as its agent and attorney in fact, which appointment is coupled with an interest, to act for and in its behalf to execute, verify and file any such documents and to do all other lawfully permitted acts to further the purposes of this section with the same legal force and effect as if executed by Assignor. Assignor hereby waives any and all claims against Assignee, of any nature whatsoever, which Assignor now or may hereafter have for infringement of any Property assigned hereunder.

4. **WARRANTY.** Assignor represents and warrants to the Assignee that: (a) to the best of its knowledge, the Property represents 100% of the Intellectual Property Rights in any assets or property owned, licensed to or used by Assignor in its business or contemplated business; (b) Assignor has all necessary rights to assign the Property and grant the rights assigned herein; (c) Assignor has full right and power to enter into and perform this Agreement without the consent of any third party; (d) all of the Property is free and clear of all claims, liens, encumbrances and the like of any nature whatsoever; (e) none of the Property infringes, misappropriates, conflicts with or violates any Intellectual Property Right or similar rights of any third party; and (f) Assignor has maintained the Property in confidence.

5. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND RELEASE.**



6. **GENERAL.**

6.1 **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement and the Attachments attached hereto constitute the entire, complete, final and exclusive understanding and agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof, and supersede any other prior or contemporaneous understanding, agreement or communication, whether oral or written. No modification of or amendment to this Agreement, nor any waiver of any rights under this Agreement, will be effective unless in writing and signed by the parties hereto. This Agreement

may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which shall be taken together and deemed to be one instrument. The provisions hereof shall inure to the benefit of, and be binding upon, the successors, assigns, heirs, executors and administrators of the parties hereto.

6.2 **Governing Law and Venue.** This Agreement and any action related thereto will be governed and interpreted by and under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, without giving effect to any conflicts of laws principles. The parties consent and agree that any suit, action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Agreement only be brought in state or federal courts sitting in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

6.3 **Injunctive Relief.** Assignor further agrees that, in the event of any breach or threatened breach by Assignor of any covenant, obligation or other provision contained in this Agreement, the Assignee shall be entitled, without limitation, to: (a) a decree or order of specific performance or mandamus to enforce the observance and performance of such covenant, obligation or other provision; and (b) an injunction restraining such breach or threatened breach. Assignor further agrees that the Assignee shall not be required to obtain, furnish, post or otherwise provide any bond or other security or instrument in connection with or as a condition to obtaining any remedy referred to in this section, and Assignor irrevocably waives any right Assignor may have to require the Assignee to obtain, furnish or post any such bond or instrument.

6.4 **Severability.** If any provision of this Agreement is found invalid or unenforceable, in whole or in part, the remaining provisions and partially enforceable provisions will, nevertheless, be binding and enforceable, and the invalid or unenforceable provision will be deemed modified so that it is valid and enforceable to the maximum extent permitted by law.

6.5 **Waiver.** Failure by either party to exercise any of its rights hereunder shall not constitute or be deemed a waiver or forfeiture of such rights.

6.6 **Notice.** All notices required by or relating to this Agreement will be in writing and shall be delivered by hand, via nationally-recognized overnight courier, or mailed first class certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, postage paid, to the parties to the Agreement at the addresses set forth above. Each party may change its address for receipt of notice by giving notice of such change to the other party.
