ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I Kris Van Assche (hereinafter "the Assignor"), a citizen of Belgium, having an address at 30 Avenue Montaigne, Paris, 75008 France, have invented a new and useful design for a SHOE HOOK, for which an application for United States Design Letters Patent is to be filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and for which WIPO Registration Number DM/083985, was filed on May 6, 2014; and

which a patent or patents may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner For Patents to issue any and all Letters Patent on the aforesaid invention or resulting from the aforesaid application directly to the Assignee.

Assignor hereby authorizes the Assignee and its successors to apply for a patent or patents directly in its own name upon the aforesaid invention wherever the same is permitted by law, and also assigns, sells, transfers and sets over unto the Assignee and its successors all priority rights under the aforesaid application.

Assignor further covenants to execute all additional instruments and to do all things necessary to carry out the purpose of this instrument, at the expense of the Assignee and its successors.
