ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

Yum Tools expressly agrees to obtain, execute, acknowledge and deliver such documents and other instruments that may be required to evidence or effectuate the sale, conveyance, assignment, transfer and delivery of the Assigned Patents to Lifetime.

Nothing in this Assignment of Patents shall be deemed to supersede, enlarge or modify any of the provisions of the Agreement, all of which shall survive the execution and delivery of this Assignment of Patents as provided in, and subject to the limitations set forth in, the Agreement. If any conflict exists between the terms of this Assignment of Patents and the terms of the Agreement or if any defined terms are not defined herein, the terms and definitions of the Agreement shall govern and control.

Except to the extent that federal law preempts state law with respect to the matters covered hereby, this Assignment of Patents shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York without regard to the principles of conflicts of laws thereunder.

This Assignment of Patents may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all of which shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

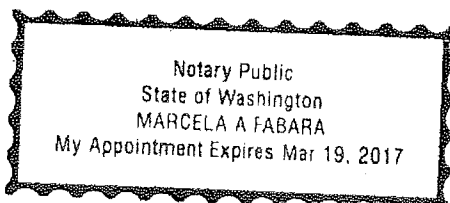
