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PATENT

This **PATENT ASSIGNMENT AND LICENCE AGREEMENT** is made the 28 day of August 2013 ("Effective Date")

BETWEEN

ARM LIMITED whose registered office is situated at 110 Fulbourn Road, Cambridge CB1 9NJ, England ("Assignor");

and

u-blox AG whose principal place of business is situated at Zuercherstrasse 68, 8800 Thalwil, Switzerland ("Assignee").

WHEREAS, Assignor is the proprietor of, or applicant for, the patents and patent applications listed in Schedule A (Assigned Patents defined below), and

WHEREAS the Assignor has agreed to assign Assigned Patents to the Assignee on the terms set out in this assignment and the Assignee has agreed to licence the Assignor under the Assigned Patents, the Assignor and the Assignee agree as follows:

1. Definitions

1.1 "Patents" means the patents and patent applications listed in Schedule A and all patent applications, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, re-examinations, re-issues (and non-US equivalents) which claim priority from the patent applications referred to in schedule A.

2. Assignment

2.1 In consideration of the sum of Ten Thousand Pounds (£10,000), receipt of which the Assignor expressly acknowledges, the Assignor hereby assigns to the Assignee absolutely all its right, title and interest in and to the Assigned Patents, and in and to all and any inventions disclosed in the Assigned Patents, including:

- (a) in respect of any and each application in the Assigned Patents:
 - (i) the right to claim priority from and to prosecute and obtain grant of patent; and
 - (ii) the right to file divisional applications based thereon and to prosecute and obtain grant of patent on each and any such divisional application;
- (b) in respect of each and any invention disclosed in the Assigned Patents, the right to file an application, claim priority from such application, and prosecute and obtain grant of patent or similar protection in or in respect of any country or territory in the world;
- (c) the right to extend to or register in, or in respect of, any country or territory in the world each and any of the Assigned Patents, and each and any of the applications comprised in the Assigned Patents or filed as aforesaid, and to extend to or register in or in respect of any country or territory in the world any patent or like protection granted on any of such applications;
- (d) the absolute entitlement to any patents granted pursuant to any of the applications comprised in the Assigned Patents or filed as aforesaid; and
- (e) the right to bring, make, oppose, defend, appeal proceedings, claims or actions and obtain relief (and to retain any damages recovered) in respect of any infringement, or any other cause of action arising from ownership, of any of the Assigned Patents or any patents granted on any of the applications comprised in the Assigned Patents or filed as aforesaid, whether occurring before, on or after the date of this assignment.

2.2 Assignor hereby authorises and requests that any relevant Patent Office issues any and all Patents on said inventions or resulting from said applications or any divisions or continuations thereof to Assignee as Assignee of the entire interest.

- 2.3 Assignor agrees at the request of Assignee to execute any further documents reasonably necessary for recordation and to do any acts or execute any other documents which may be necessary to establish the transfer and vesting of the Assigned Patents and the inventions the subject thereof to Assignee under this Assignment.
- 2.4 The Assignor shall and shall use all reasonable endeavours to procure that any necessary third party shall, at the Assignee's cost, execute such documents and perform such acts as may reasonably be required for the purpose of giving full effect to this agreement.

3. Licence

- 3.1 In further consideration for the assignment, the Assignee hereby grants to the Assignor an irrevocable, royalty-free, non-exclusive, worldwide licence under the Assigned Patents to manufacture, use, keep, whether for disposal or otherwise, and sell or otherwise supply, products which fall within the claims of the Assigned Patents.
- 3.2 The Assignee hereby covenants not to sue Assignor's affiliates, licensees or customers under any of the Assigned Patents for infringement based upon any act by the Assignor of manufacture, use, sale, offer for sale, disposal, import or other act of infringement that occurs after the effective date of this Agreement.
- 3.3 Paragraphs 3.1 and 3.2 of this Agreement shall be binding on Assignee's successors or any third party to whom Assignee may assign a patent or patent application listed in Schedule A.

4. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

- 4.1 This agreement constitutes the whole agreement between the parties and supersedes all previous agreements between the parties relating to its subject matter.
- 4.2 Each party acknowledges that, in entering into this agreement, it has not relied on, and shall have no right or remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether made negligently or innocently) other than as expressly set out in this agreement.

5. VARIATION

- 5.1 No variation of this agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by the parties (or their authorised representatives).

6. SEVERANCE

- 6.1 If any court or competent authority finds that any provision of this agreement (or part of any provision) is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision or part-provision shall, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this agreement shall not be affected.
- 6.2 If any invalid, unenforceable or illegal provision of this agreement would be valid, enforceable and legal if some part of it were deleted, the provision shall apply with the minimum modification necessary to make it legal, valid and enforceable.

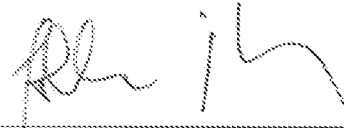
7. GENERAL

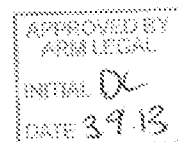
