THIS ASSIGNMENT is made October 24, 2014

BETWEEN

Du Pont Kabushiki Kaisha, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of Japan, having a principal of business at Sanno Park Tower, 11-1, Nagata-cho 2-chome, Chiyodu-ku, Tokyo 100-6111, Japan (hereinafter "the Assignor"), AND

E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, United States of America, and having a principal place of business at 1007 Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19898, United States of America (hereinafter "the Assignee"),

WHEREAS Du Pont Kabushiki Kaisha is a one hundred percent (100%) subsidiary of E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Company;

WHEREAS YUJI SAGA of Kiyohara-kogyodanchi, Utsunomiya, Tochigi, Japan and TAKASHI HIRAHARA of Kiyohara-kogyodanchi, Utsunomiya, Tochigi, Japan ("the Inventors") are the inventors of ELECTRICALLY INSULATING AND THERMALLY CONDUCTIVE POLYMER COMPOSITIONS ("the invention") disclosed in Japanese Patent Application No. 2013-209304, filed on October 04, 2013 (DuPont Docket Number: AD8071JPNP);

the Assignor HEREBY ASSIGNS and transfers unto the Assignee with effect from October 04, 2013 ("Effective Date") its entire right, title and interest in and to:

- (1) the aforesaid patent application,
 - (2) any priority rights derived from the aforesaid patent application by virtue of the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and any other treaty or understanding for intellectual property for any and all member countries of the aforesaid International Convention or other treaty or understanding,
 - (3) any and all inventions disclosed in the aforesaid patent application,
 - (4) any and all patent applications for such inventions in and for any country whatsoever, including the Japanese Patent Application No. 2013-209304,
 - (5) any and all patents for any such inventions in any country whatsoever,
- TO HOLD unto the Assignee absolutely.

The Assignee confirms herein that the invention is subject to the requirements of Industrial Technology Enhancement Act of Japan and the Assignor promises to fulfill the report obligations imposed by NEDO on behalf of the Assignee.
