**WHEREAS, Lifestyle Products LLC** (“Assignee”) desires to acquire by formal, recordable assignment their entire right, title, and interest in and to said Invention, and said Patent Application in the United States and throughout the world.



This assignment and agreement shall be binding upon any and all heirs and legal representatives of Assignors.



FIG. 5 is a front view showing the design;

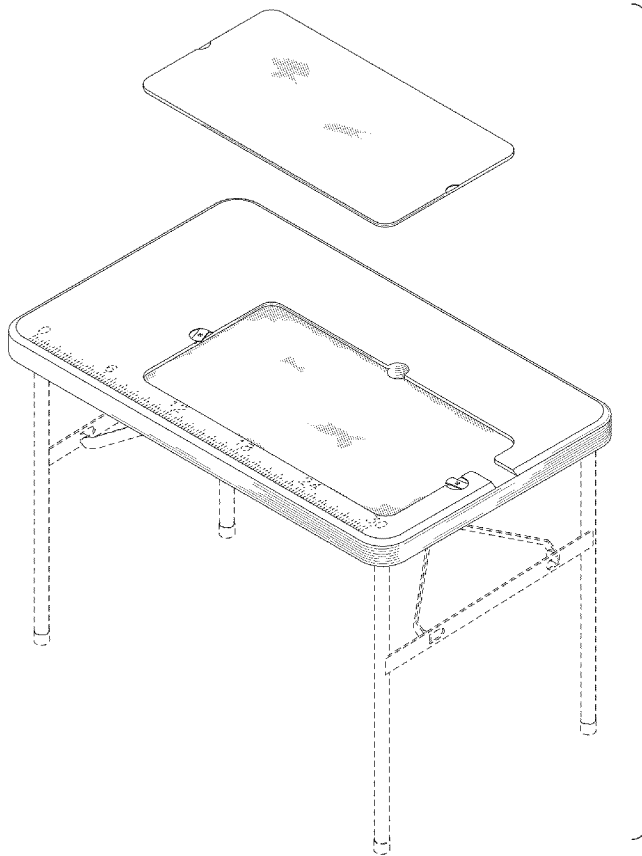
FIG. 6 is a back view showing the design;

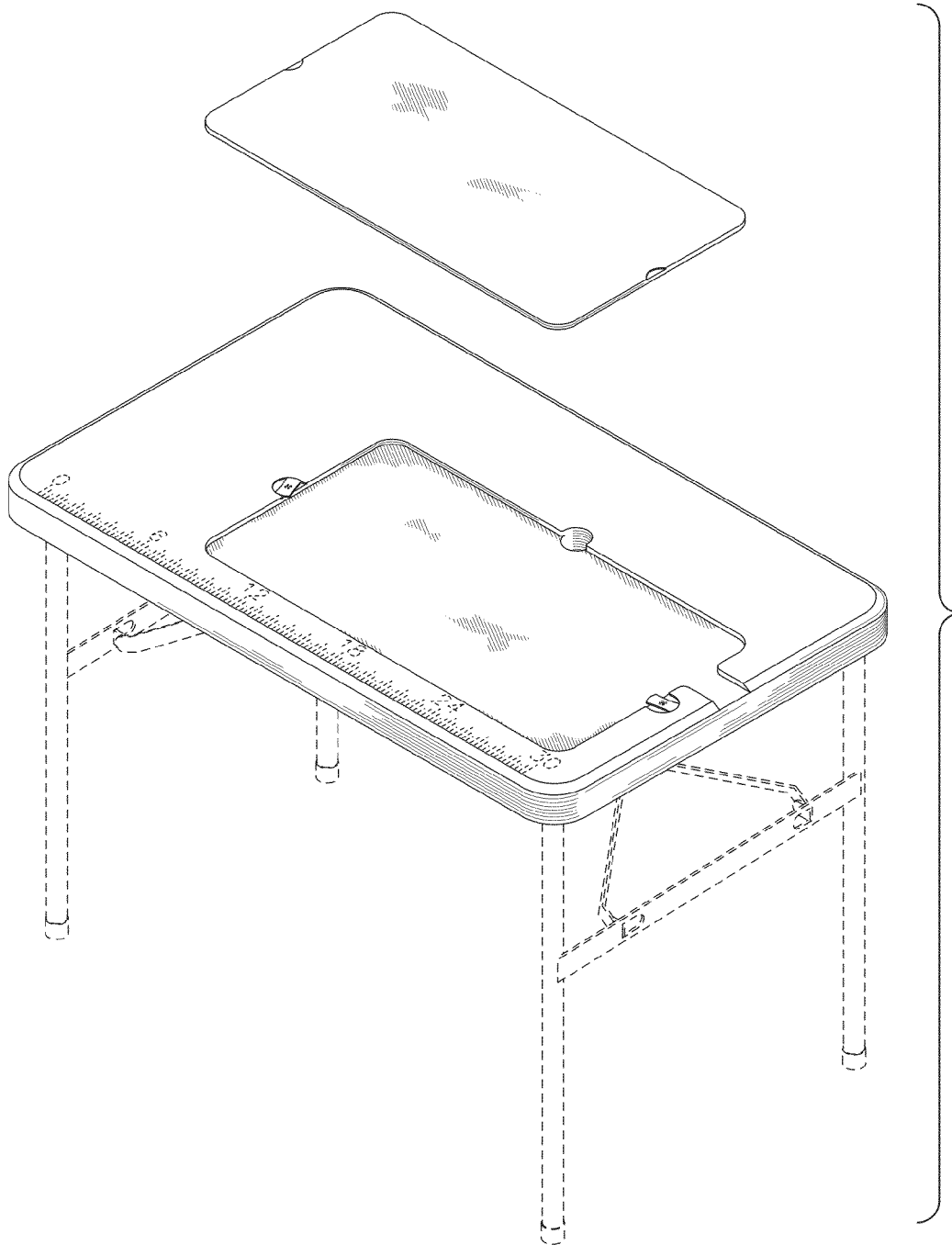

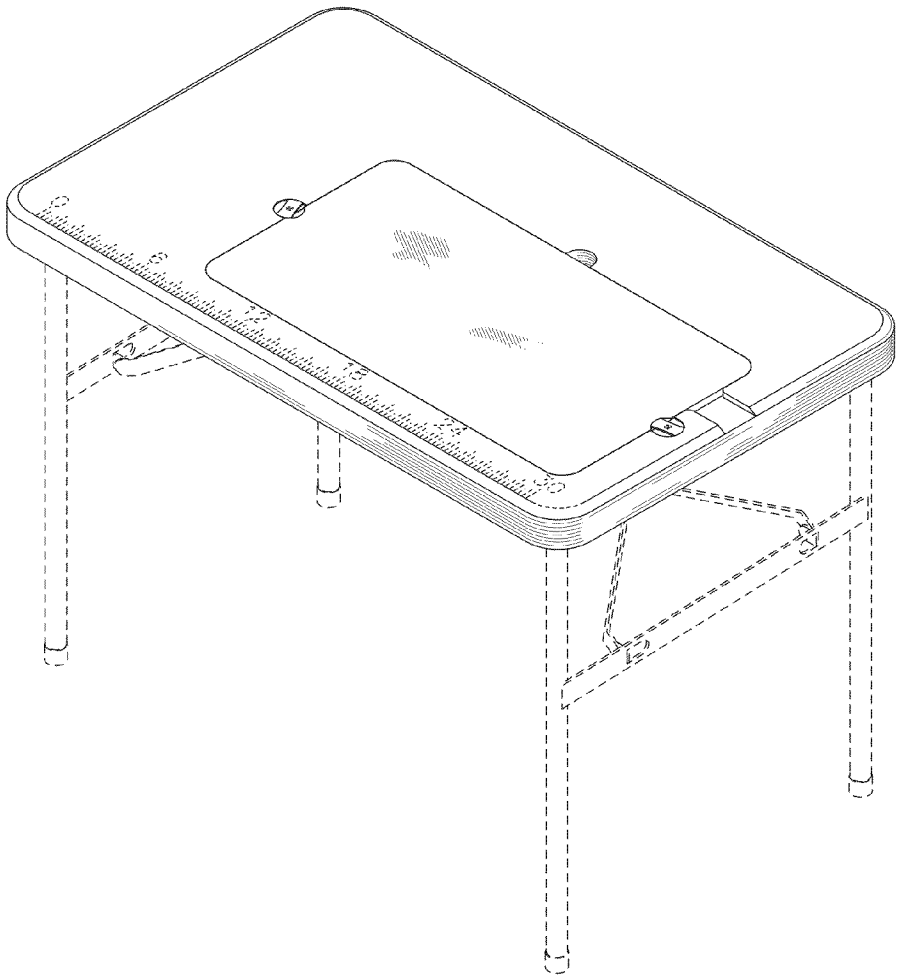

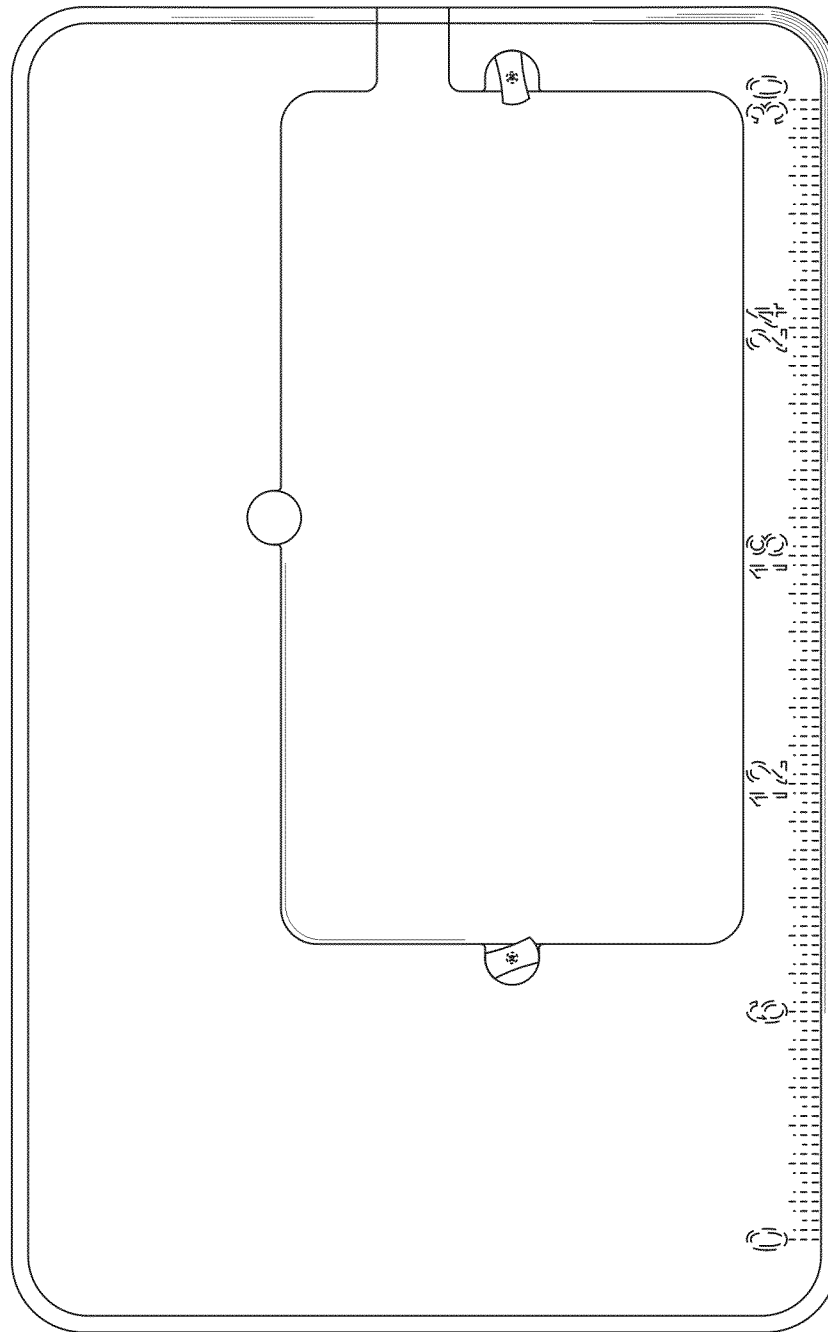

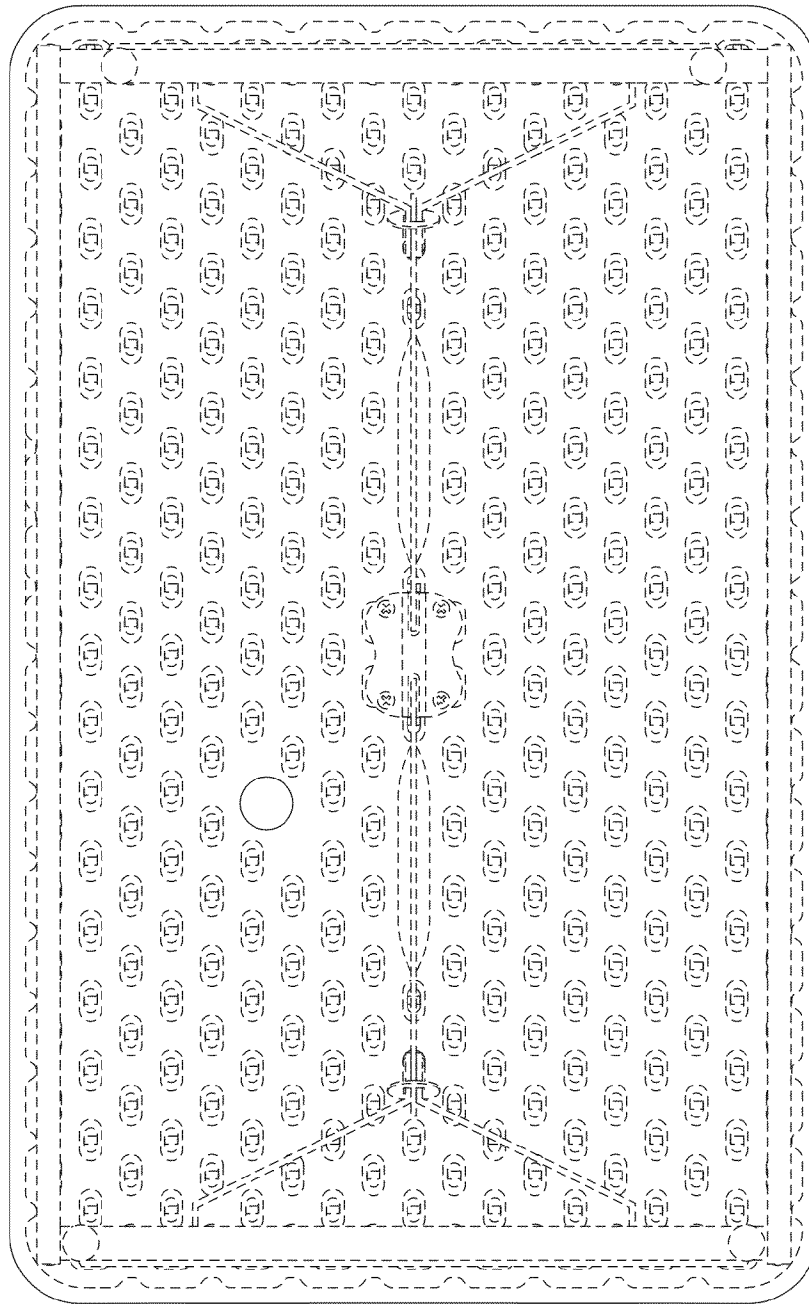
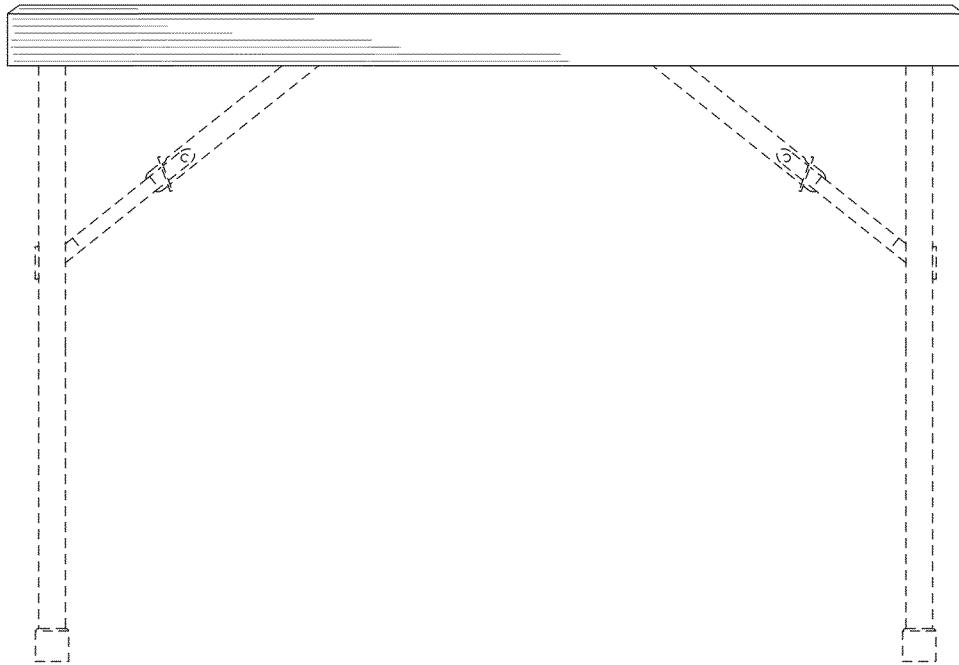
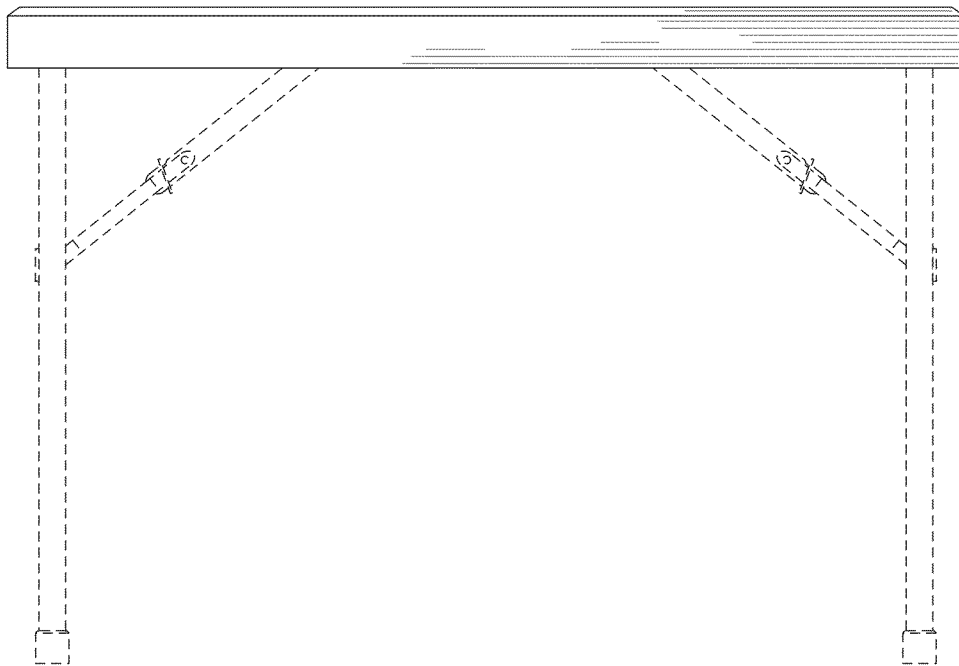

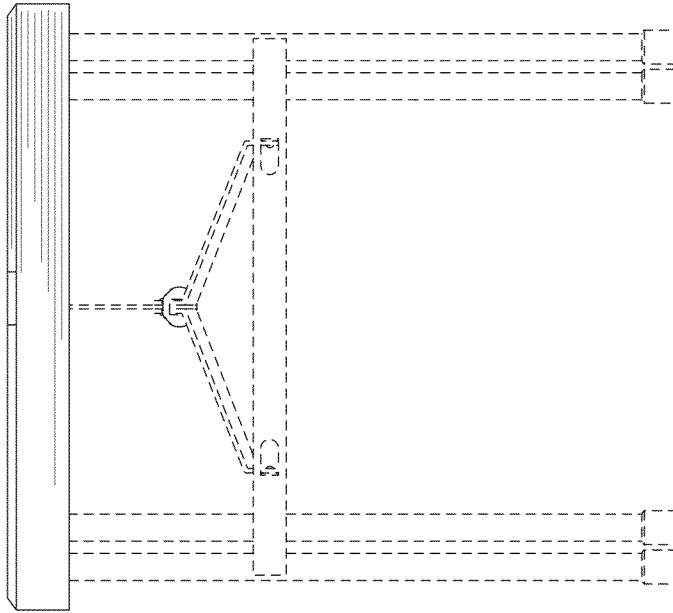

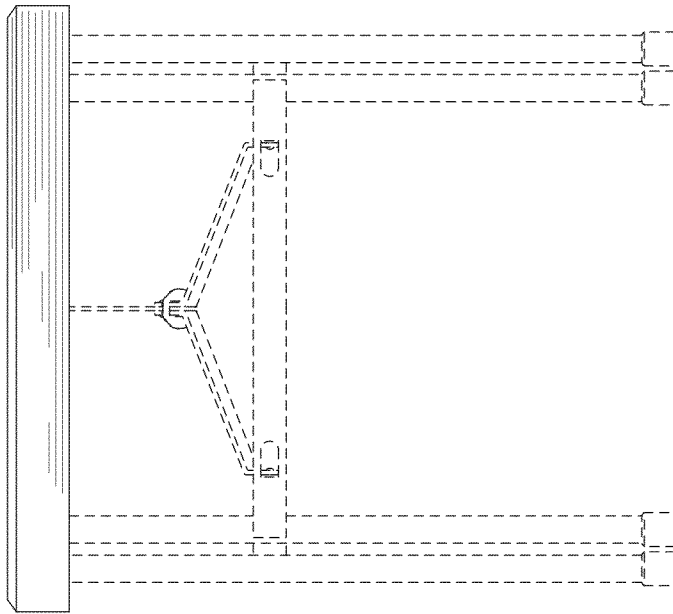
