

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1 In this Deed, unless the context requires otherwise:

Assigned Rights means without limitation, throughout the Territory:

- (a) all rights, title and interest, including but not limited to all Intellectual Property Rights, subsisting in the Inventions and Patents, free of all Encumbrances;
- (b) where applicable, all rights to apply for, prosecute and obtain patent protection in respect of the Inventions; and
- (c) all rights to take action and obtain relief (whether as damages, an account of profits or on any other basis) in relation to infringements of any Intellectual Property Rights assigned under this Deed.

Corresponding Patent Application means any patent application filed anywhere in world claiming the Inventions, any part of the Inventions or any improvements to the Inventions, including without limitation, any application made under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) or national or regional phase applications deriving from such PCT applications, divisional, continuations, continuations in part, re-issued, substituted or re-filed applications or any applications for patents of addition filed anywhere in the world.

Encumbrance means mortgage, pledge, charge, assignment of security or other encumbrance.

Intellectual Property Rights means any and all rights in respect of or comprised in any inventions (including patent), copyright (including future copyright and rights in the nature of or analogous to copyright), design, trade mark, eligible layout or similar right whether conferred by statute or common law, and rights to protect trade secrets, know how or confidential information, throughout the world whether such rights are afforded protection by a system of registration or not, and includes all rights to apply for registration of such rights where applicable, and any improvements to the aforementioned rights.

Inventions means a table top ball game more readily described by the inventions that are the subject of the Patents.

Patents means without limitation:

- (a) the patent registrations listed in the Schedule;
- (b) where applicable, any Corresponding Patent Applications; and
- (c) where applicable, any other application for the protection of any Intellectual Property Rights made in relation to or concerning the Inventions, whether or not made under any relevant cross-jurisdictional treaties, including, without limitation, the Paris Convention, the Patent Cooperation Treaty or the Madrid Protocol.

Territory means worldwide.

1. CONSIDERATION AND ASSIGNMENT

1.1 In consideration of the Assignee paying to the Assignor the sum of \$10 (receipt of which is acknowledged by the Assignor), the Assignor hereby assigns to the Assignee all the Assigned Rights.

2. OBLIGATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 2.1 At the expense of Assignee, the Assignor must do all acts and execute all documents necessary or desirable for give Assignee absolute title to the Inventions and the benefit of the Assigned Rights.
- 2.2 The Assignor must not, whether before or after executing this Deed, do any act which would or might:
- (a) invalidate or put in dispute Assignee's title to the Inventions or Patents, or the Intellectual Property Rights in any of them;
 - (b) support an application by any person to challenge, invalidate or remove any Patents from any register anywhere in the world;
 - (c) cause a Commissioner of Patents, Registrar of Trade Marks or other like authority to require any Patents to be removed from any register anywhere in the world;
 - (d) assist any person directly or indirectly in the acts listed in (a), (b) and (c) above.

3. GENERAL

- 3.1 Nothing in this Deed implies or creates a partnership between Assignor and Assignee. Assignor has no right to bind Assignee or execute any other agreement on its behalf.
- 3.2 No amendment or variation of this Deed is valid or binding unless made in writing executed by the parties.
- 3.3 No party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under this Deed other than by novation of all of its rights and obligations under this Deed.
- 3.4 No forbearance, failure or delay by a party in exercising any right, power or privilege under or with respect to this Deed operates as a waiver of such right, power or privilege. No single or partial exercise of any such right, power or privilege precludes any other or further exercise of such right, power or privilege or the exercise of any other right, power or privilege.
- 3.5 Any provision of this Deed which is deemed voidable, void, illegal or unenforceable in any jurisdiction (**Ineffective**) is Ineffective only to that extent in that jurisdiction. Where any clause or part of that clause is Ineffective, it may be severed without affecting any other part of this Deed.
- 3.6 This Deed:
- (a) records the entire agreement between the parties with respect to its subject matter and replaces all representations, warranties or proposals not set out in this Deed in respect of its subject matter;
 - (b) may be executed in any number of counterparts and will come into effect when it is executed by each party and each party, or party's legal representative, has received by way of delivery, an original or facsimile copy of an executed counterpart of the Deed by the other party;
 - (c) is governed by the laws applicable in the State of Victoria, Australia and the parties irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts situated in Victoria and any courts of appeal from them; and
 - (d) binds each party and their respective successors in title and permitted assigns.
