ASSIGNMENT

Kenneth C. Lenz, Jr. residing at 917 Greenly Street, Hudsonville, Michigan 49426 and Richard R. Lagerquist residing at 780 N. Main St., Apt. 1, Plainwell, Michigan 49080 (individually and/or collectively Assignor) have invented certain new and useful improvements in FIREFIGHTING OR RESCUE APPARATUS INCLUDING A LADDER MOUNTED RECOVERY WINCH for which a United States patent application was executed on even date herewith.

Assignor authorizes and requests the patent office officials in the United States and in all foreign countries to issue all of the patents, when granted, to Assignee as the owner of the entire right, title, and interest in and to the same.

Assignor agrees to communicate to Assignee or its representatives all facts known to Assignor respecting the invention; to testify in all legal proceedings; to sign all documents; to execute all nonprovisional, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, reexamination, substitution, renewal, and extension applications; to execute all necessary assignment documents to cause all of the patents to be issued to Assignee, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for the invention in the United States and in all foreign countries.
