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PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Patent Assignment Agreement (the "Agreement"), is entered into as of the last date below written (the "Effective Date") and is by and between Tapco International Corporation, a Michigan corporation ("Assignor") with offices located at 29797 Beck Road, Wixom, Michigan 48393, and David James Bonshor, an individual ("Assignee") residing at 19782 28th Avenue, Langley, British Columbia, V2Z-1Y1.

WHEREAS:

A. Assignor received rights under prior agreements with Assignee to the entire right, title and interest in, and to the Patents and Patent Applications identified by USPTO Serial Number and Title on the attached Schedule A (collectively, the "Patents,") and of the invention(s) therein described (collectively, the "Patent Property"); and

B. Assignee desires to obtain the return the entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents and the Patent Property (collectively, the "Intellectual Property") subject to the terms of this Agreement and the Settlement and Release Agreement between the parties of even date herewith (the "Release"); and

C. Assignor and Assignee have agreed to resolve certain issues between them in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and the Release; and

D. Assignor is willing to assign the entire right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property back to Assignee subject to Assignor's agreement to license the Intellectual Property to Assignor on a non-exclusive basis; and

E. Assignee is willing to receive the assignment of the Intellectual Property subject to a license for the same as set forth below in favor of Assignor.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of TEN DOLLARS (\$10) and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree to the following terms.

1. **Assignment.** Assignor does hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives, and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to the Intellectual Property, including the right to sue for past infringement, and all patents of the United States or other countries which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof; and all applications for industrial property protection, including, without limitation, all applications for patents, utility models, and designs which have already been and which may hereafter be filed based upon the Intellectual Property or any portion of it in any country or countries foreign to the United States, together with the right to file such applications and the right to claim for the same the priority rights derived from the patent under the patent laws of the United States, the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, or any other international agreement or the domestic laws of the country in which any such application is filed, as may be applicable; and all forms of industrial property protection, including, without limitation, patents, utility models, inventors' certificates and designs which may be granted for said invention in any country or countries foreign to the United States and all extensions, renewals and reissues thereof.

2. **Authorization to Issue Patents to Assignee.** Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States, and any official of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents to issue the

same to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

3. **License.** Assignee hereby grants to Assignor a non-exclusive, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free, sub-licensable right and license to use any portion or all of the Intellectual Property as it deems appropriate for business purposes.

4. **Cooperation Following the Execution.** Following the execution of this Agreement, each party shall deliver to the other such further information and documents and shall execute and deliver to the other such further instruments and agreements as the other party shall reasonably request to consummate or confirm the transactions provided for in this Agreement, to accomplish the intentions of the parties with this Agreement or to assure to the other party the benefits of this Agreement. Assignee specifically agrees diligently to pursue the release of any and all security interests that have attached or which may attach to the Patents or Patent Property resulting from acts of the Assignee.

5. **Assignee's Grant of License to Assignor to Utilize Future Derivative Property.** Assignee agrees that the license above in favor of Assignor shall extend to any intellectual property embodied in any extensions, any patents and any patent applications of the parties that arise from the patents assigned by this instrument (the "Derivative Property"),


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regardless of whether protection for such Derivative Property is obtained after the Effective Date of this Agreement.
