WHEREAS, Sean H. Assignor further covenants that Assignees will, upon their request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said invention, said Nonprovisional Patent Application, and said Letters Patent and legal equivalents thereof in foreign countries as may be known and accessible to Assignor and will testify as to the same in any interference or litigation

related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to Assignees or their legal representatives any and all papers, instruments, or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue, and/or enforce said invention, said Nonprovisional Patent Application, and said Letters Patent and legal equivalents thereof in foreign countries which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes thereof.
