WHEREAS, Assignor is the inventor of the invention disclosed and claimed in U.S. Patent No. US 8,476,541 B1 entitled "JUNCTION/OUTLET BOX LOCKING INSERT, JUNCTION/OUTLET BOX SYSTEM AND METHOD," filed November 10, 2011, issued July 2, 2013 and the related Provisional Patent Application filed March 15, 2011 having serial number 61/465,173, and wishes to transfer the Patent, related Patent Applications and all rights relating thereto (Invention) to Assignee; and

WHEREAS, Assignee wishes to accept the Patent, related Patent Applications and all rights relating thereto (Invention);

1. Assignment. Assignor hereby irrevocably conveys, transfers and assigns to Assignee, and Assignee hereby accepts, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Invention and any patent application relating thereto, together with all issuances, divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, extensions, reexaminations and renewals thereof, and comparable applications based thereon or on any corresponding foreign patent applications, and any and all Letters Patent or comparable rights issuing thereon in the United States and in all foreign countries, together with all rights of priority based on the filing of any of the aforesaid applications arising under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and any and all other international agreements to which the United States of America adheres (collectively, "Assigned Patents");

(a) all rights of any kind whatsoever of Assignor accruing under any of the foregoing provided by applicable law of any jurisdiction, by international treaties and conventions and otherwise throughout the world;

(b) any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing; and

(c) any and all claims and causes of action, with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on and/or after the date hereof, including all rights to and claims for


damages, restitution and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for past, present and future infringement, misappropriation, violation, misuse, breach or default, with the right but no obligation to sue for such legal and equitable relief and to collect, or otherwise recover, any such damages.


