PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This Patent Assignment ("Assignment") is entered into this 24 day of June, 2015, between Edward L. Sinofsky, ("Assignor"), and PhotoGlow, Inc. ("Assignee").

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Transfer of Assigned Patent Rights. Assignor hereby irrevocably sells, conveys, transfers, assigns and delivers to Assignee and its successors and assigns, all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in, to and under the Assigned Patent Rights and all inventions in the United States and throughout the world (with priority rights) in and to the Assigned Patent Rights, and in and to any corresponding domestic applications (e.g., continuations, continuations-in-part, divisionals, reexaminations, reissues and/or extensions), any corresponding foreign applications, all patents issuing thereon, or other patent applications based off or claiming priority to the Assigned Patent Rights, together with all of the goodwill associated with any and all of the foregoing, any and all causes of action (in law or equity) and rights to sue, counterclaim and/or collect and recover for past, present or future infringement of, or damage or injury to, the Assigned Patent Rights or such associated goodwill, and all rights to file for and maintain registrations, renewals and extensions of the Assigned Patent Rights, the same to be held and enjoyed by Assignee, its successors, and permitted assigns.

2. Further Assurances. Assignor shall execute and deliver, without any further consideration, any and all instruments and documents and take such further actions as may be necessary or reasonably requested by Assignee and any assigns of the Assignee to document and record with the appropriate authorities the aforesaid assignment and transfer, provided that Assignee shall be solely responsible for filing and recording such documents. Assignor shall render all assistance in filing, obtaining, maintaining and enforcing any patent (or similar legal protection) resulting from or based off the Assigned Patent Rights in any and all countries.

3. Authorizations. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, and any other official throughout the world whose duty is to register and record ownership of patents and applications therefor, to record Assignee as the owner of the applicable Assigned Patent Rights and to issue the United States Letters

Patents (or foreign equivalents) resulting from all the applications in the Assigned Patent Rights to Assignee and its successors and assigns.

4. Counterparts. This Assignment may be executed manually or by facsimile or electronic signature by the parties, in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be considered one and the same agreement and shall become effective when a counterpart hereof shall have been signed by each of the parties and delivered to the other party. Assignee shall have the right to retain the Assignor's manual signature version.

5. Governing Law. This Assignment shall be construed, performed, and enforced in accordance with, and governed by, the internal laws of the State of Delaware, without giving effect to the principles of conflict of law thereof.

6. Successors; Assigns. This Assignment shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties thereto and their respective successors and permitted assigns.

7. Conflicting Assignments. Assignor represents to the assignee that Assignor has not and shall not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with this Assignment.

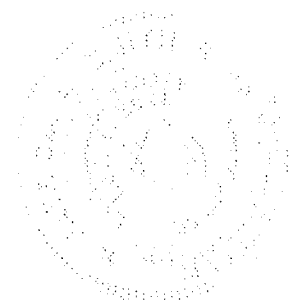

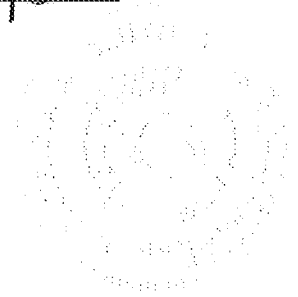
