Petition and Preamble

To the Commissioner of the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office:

Your petitioner, Paul Petzl, a citizen or subject of France, prays that Letters Patent be granted to him for the new and original design for a SAFETY HELMET as set forth in the following specification:

Specification

Be it known that I, the above named petitioner, have invented a new, original and ornamental design for a SAFETY HELMET of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings forming a part hereof.

Figure 1 is a front, left-side perspective view of the SAFETY HELMET;

Figure 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

Figure 3 is a top plan view thereof;

Figure 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof, which is a mirror image of the right-side elevational view thereof,

Figure 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

Figure 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken lines depict environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design.

The ornamental design for a SAFETY HELMET as shown and described.

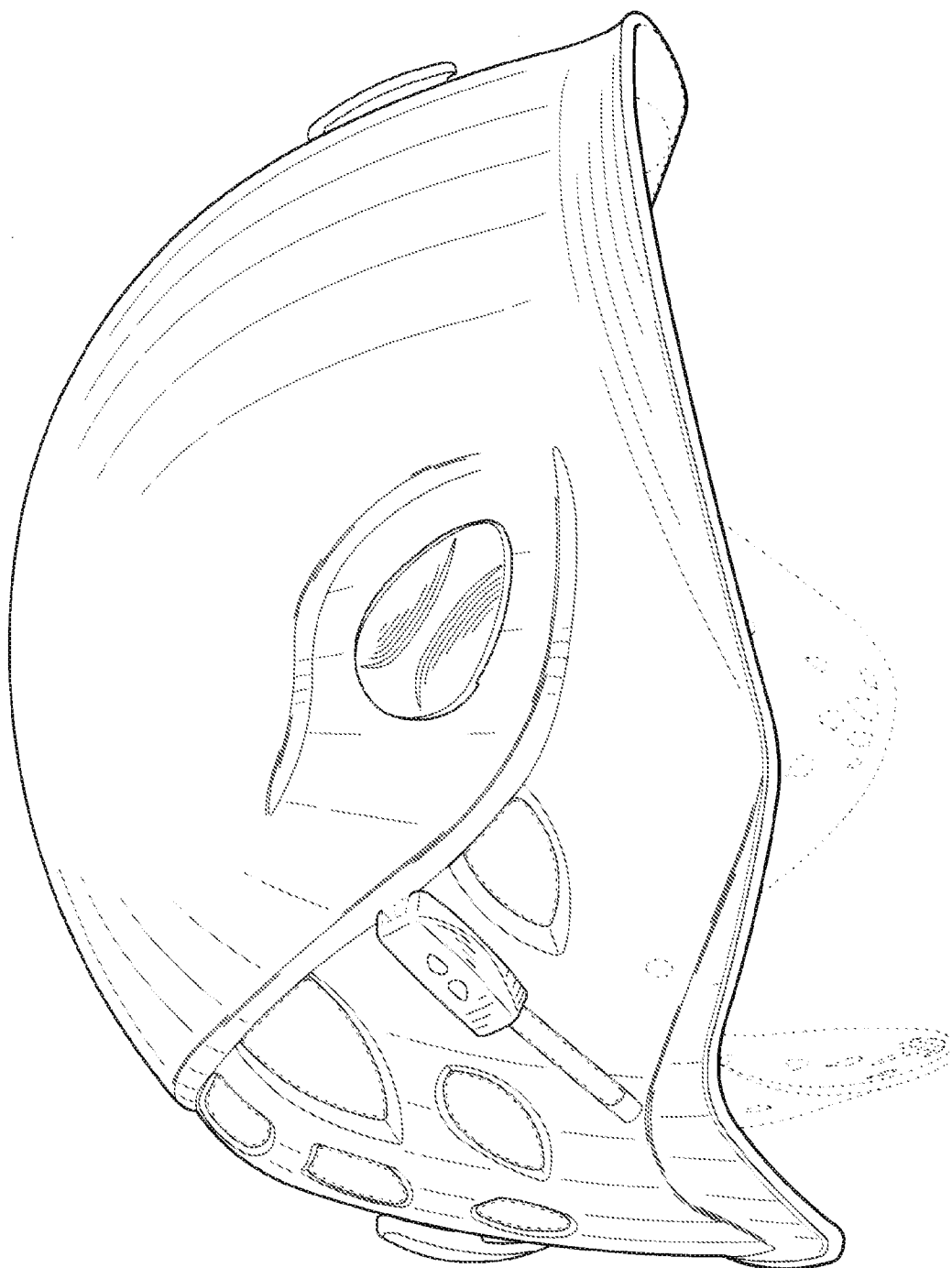
