Notwithstanding the foregoing, Assignor retains an irrevocable, world-wide, royalty-free, non-exclusive right to use the inventions claimed in the Applications for teaching, research and educational purposes and may also sublicense such right to one or more non-profit academic or research institutions, provided that Assignor uses all reasonable efforts to provide advance written notice to Assignee of such sublicense and provided further that any such sublicense shall expressly prohibit any such sublicensee from further sublicensing the rights vested in the Assignor in this sentence.

Assignor hereby authorizes said Assignee, its successors and assigns, or anyone it may properly designate, to apply for Letters Patent, in its own name if desired, in any and all foreign



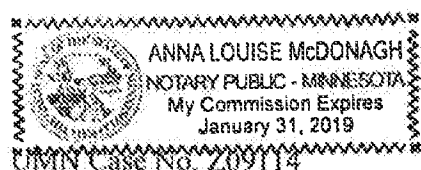
