WHEREAS, by virtue of another assignment effective June 1, 2012, said assignment having been recorded in the Canadian Intellectual Property Office under Registration No. 05586976, Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to Canadian Patent No. 2,543,592, which claims priority to U.S. Provisional Patent Application Serial No. 60/751,623;

WHEREAS, the Assignor and Assignee are parties to (i) a patent license agreement dated as of July 1, 2013 pursuant to which Assignor granted to Assignee a

right and license to use Canadian Patent No. 2,543,592; and (ii) another patent license agreement dated as of July 1, 2013 pursuant to which Assignor granted to Assignee a right and license to use U.S. Patent No. 8,169,169 (collectively, the "Patent License Agreements");

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is acknowledged, Assignor has agreed to assign and transfer and does hereby assign and transfer unto Assignee, its successors and assigns, its entire right, title and interest in and to U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 11/403,490; U.S. Patent No. 8,169,169; U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 14/319,076, Canadian Patent No. 2,543,592, and U.S. Provisional Patent Application Serial No. 60/751,623, including the inventions disclosed in all of the foregoing and all applications and patents therefor, and in and to any divisionals, continuations or continuations-in-part of the applications and patents set forth above, and in and to any and all patents and reissues and extensions thereof, of The United States of America and countries foreign thereto, including the right to sue and collect for any and all past infringements thereof, (and further including the right to apply for patents in foreign countries in its own name and to claim any priority rights for such foreign applications to which such applications are entitled under international conventions, treaties, or otherwise), which have been or may be granted on any of the foregoing to be held and enjoyed as fully and exclusively as they would have been by Assignor had this assignment and transfer not been made;

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Patent License Agreements, Assignor and Assignee agree to and do hereby terminate the Patent License Agreements and agree that section 4.1 of the respective Patent License Agreements shall not survive such termination;

Assignor does hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States and the appropriate representative in all other Patent Offices throughout the world to record this Patent Assignment to Assignee as the assignee of the entire interests therein.

This Patent Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Quebec and the Laws of Canada applicable therein (without regard to any conflict of law principles found herein).

This Patent Assignment shall enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns.
