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**PATENT ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, **Fixmo, Inc.** (hereinafter referred to as the "ASSIGNOR"), a Company organized under the laws of the province of Ontario, Canada, having a place of business at 15 Toronto Street, Suite 1100, Toronto, Ontario M5C 2E3, Canada, owns the full and exclusive right, title and interest in the applications for patent listed in Schedule A (collectively, the "Applications") and the inventions, invention disclosures and discoveries disclosed in the Applications (collectively, the "Inventions"):

AND WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR and **Good Technology Corporation** (hereinafter referred to as the "ASSIGNEE"), a company organized under the laws of Delaware, U.S.A., having a place of business at 430 N. - (ii) all patents and patent applications that are a member of the same Patent Family as any one of the Applications; where

"Patent Family" means a set comprised of all patents and patent applications that are (a) directly or indirectly linked or entitled to be linked through one or more Priority Claim or by a terminal disclaimer (including under 35 U.S.C. Sec. 253 or 37 CFR 1.321 or the equivalent laws or regulation of any other patent authority) or (b) that are foreign counterparts, reissues, divisionals, renewals, extensions, continuations or continuations-in-part with respect to any other patent or patent application in such set; and

“Priority Claim” means a claim to priority made in any patent or patent application to any other patent or patent application pursuant to 35 U.S.C. Secs. 120 or 119(e) or the equivalent claim to priority under the laws and regulations applicable to a foreign patent or patent application, as the case may be; and

(iii) all foreign counterparts of any of the foregoing patents and patent applications;

in each case whether pending, issued, expired, abandoned or closed, and including all income, royalties, damages and payments due (including, without limitation, all benefits, privileges, powers, rights, causes of action and rights to damages and payments for past, present or future infringements or misappropriations) with respect thereto, in each case, in all countries relating to the Assigned Patents.

ASSIGNOR does hereby agree, upon request, to provide assistance and to execute any and all further documents, at the expense of ASSIGNEE and/or its successors and assigns (as applicable), which may be necessary or desirable to enable ASSIGNEE, and/or its successors and assigns (as applicable), to file, prosecute, bring proceedings and take other actions with respect to any and all of the Invention, Assigned Patents, and any and all patents and registrations granted thereon and other forms of protection, rights and titles relating thereto, and ASSIGNOR further agrees to execute, upon request and at the expense of ASSIGNEE and/or its successors and assigns (as applicable), any and all further documents which may be necessary or desirable to vest or perfect the title of ASSIGNEE therein.

ASSIGNOR does hereby authorize ASSIGNEE or its patent agents or attorneys to insert, above, the jurisdictions, application numbers, filing dates and any other indicia identifying the Applications when such information is available for the purpose of recording this assignment.




