Assignor hereby further agrees to assist in and execute all documents needed now or in the future to perfect, obtain, and secure the aforementioned rights to Assignee, its legal representatives, successors, and assigns, for any jurisdiction in the world. 


Re: Delegation of authority to the Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Research, Prof. Gianpietro Cossali, for signing documents whose purpose is to apply for, manage and account for funding of research and technology transfer projects.

THE CHANCELLOR

RECALLING his Decree No. 17900/II/003 of 18 September 2012, whereby Prof. Gianpietro Cossali is confirmed as the University's Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Research under Article 18(4) of its Statutes until the end of the Chancellor's mandate:

CONSIDERING the need to simplify and shorten the administrative process by delegating to the Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Research, Prof. Gianpietro Cossali, the signing of documents required to apply for, manage and account for research funds:

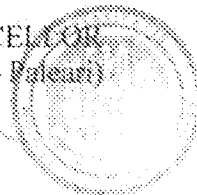
DECREES

1. To delegate to the Pro-Vice-Chancellor for Research, Prof. Gianpietro Cossali, the signing of all documents falling under the Chancellor's authority as related to application for, management of and accounting of funding for research and technology transfer projects, as detailed below:
 - documents for funding applications: letters of intent, applications for funds, partnership agreements, other documents;
 - documents for international project agreements: grant preparation forms, grant agreements, consortium agreements, other agreements;
 - documents for declaring the acceptance of awarded grants and various certificates;
 - documents for agreeing the allocation to the University of the ownership of inventions and for granting to a third party the ownership of patents, licensing rights, documents for submitting patent applications and other documents;
 - documents for interim and final project accounting: statements of costs incurred, self-certifications, other statements.
2. To set the starting date of the delegation on 2 April 2013 and its closing date as the end of his mandate.
