The above-identified application was filed by Xerox Corporation (hereafter referred to as "Xerox") on December 16, 1999, naming five inventors: Meera SAMPATH, Charles P. COLEMAN, Tracy E. THIERET, Ronald M. ROCKWELL, and Charles B. DUKE (hereafter referred to as the "Inventors"). A declaration and power of attorney was executed by all of the Inventors on December 16-17, 1999 (set forth in Attachment 1).

I. Assignment Recordal Error

An assignment by three of the Inventors (i.e., Ms. SAMPATH, Ms. THIERET, and Mr. ROCKWELL), assigning those Inventors' interest in the above-identified application to Xerox was recorded on December 16, 1999 at the USPTO (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Assignment"), the recordal of which erroneously identified Mr. COLEMAN and Mr. DUKE as having also signed the Original Assignment.

The error in the recordal of the Original Assignment was brought to Xerox's attention in November of 2015 and corrected on March 15, 2016 (set forth in <u>Attachment 2</u>). In

addition, a Nuc Pro Tunc assignment, assigning Mr. DUKE's interest in the above-identified application to Xerox was recorded on November 23, 2015 (set forth in Attachment 3).

Requests of Mr. COLEMAN to execute a Nunc Pro Tunc assignment similar to Mr. DUKE were unanswered. Consequently, this ASSIGNMENT is submitted to establish the assignment of Mr. COLEMAN's interest in the above-referenced patent to Xerox as a matter of law.

II. Xerox's Routine Business Practice

Mr. Coleman was an employee of Xerox between June of 1996 and December of 2000, with employee number ending in "692" as evidenced by the redacted employee information listing set forth in <u>Attachment 4</u>.

Xerox policy, at the time Mr. COLEMAN was employed by Xerox, provided that "each person who accepts a job offer is required, as a condition of employment, to sign the 'Employee Proprietary Information and Conflict of Interest Agreement' no later than the first day of work (see Exhibit B)" (see page 1 of redacted Xerox Personnel Manual (PM) 203.3, effective April 22, 1996, set forth in Attachment 5). The Employee Proprietary Information and Conflict of Interest Agreement ("PICIA") referred to on page 1 of Attachment 5 is set forth on page 8 of Attachment 5. Further, Xerox policy, at the time Mr. COLEMAN terminated employment with Xerox, required employee records to be retained prior to their destruction for seven years following termination (see page 4 and page 7 of redacted Xerox Human Resource (HR) Manual 301.1, set forth in Attachment 6).

Accordingly, Xerox policy, as set forth in <u>Attachment 5</u> and <u>Attachment 6</u>, required that a PICIA be executed by Mr. COLEMAN no later than his first day of work and then retained for seven years following termination of employment prior to destruction. Consequently, Xerox is unable to locate a PICIA executed by Mr. COLEMAN. Examples of PICIAs of current Xerox employees executed during the calendar year of Mr. COLEMAN's

employment start date (redacted to protect personally identifiable information), and containing assignment terms identical to those required by Xerox Policy, are set forth in Attachment 7 (executed in January of 1996, preceding Mr. COLEMAN's start date) and Attachment 8 (executed in November of 1996, following Mr. COLEMAN's start date).

In addition, during the time of Mr. COLEMAN's employment, it was also Xerox's policy as provided in the PICIA to require employees to "notify Xerox of all inventions [] which [the employee] may produce during [his/her] employment with Xerox," and Xerox's routine business practice to use a standardized invention disclosure submission process for employees to submit an invention, which included the completion and submission of an Invention Disclosure form describing in general terms the nature of the invention (hereafter referred to as "Xerox ID").

III. Assignment as a Matter of Law

The PICIA that Mr. COLEMAN was required to execute no later than his first day of work with Xerox, in accordance with Xerox's routine business practice, provides in relevant part that Mr. COLEMAN, "assigns [his] right, title and interest in any patents or patent applications based on [] inventions [produced during his employment] to Xerox". On January 7, 1998, during Mr. COLEMAN's employment with Xerox, the Inventors, including Mr. COLEMAN, executed a Xerox ID for the above-referenced patent application, as evidenced by the redacted first page of Xerox ID 980075 set forth in Attachment 9. The redacted Xerox Docket File Wrapper cover set forth in Attachment 10 links Xerox ID 980075 with the above-referenced patent application.

Pursuant to the evidence provided herein, Xerox is entitled, as a matter of law, to all rights of named co-inventor Mr. Charles P. COLEMAN in the above referenced United States patent application entitled "System and Methods for Failure Prediction Diagnosis and Remediation Using Data Acquisition and Feedback for a Distributed Electronic System,"

filed on December 16, 1999, as Application Number 09/464,597, arising from Xerox ID 980075. Accordingly, Mr. Charles P. COLEMAN assigned and/or transferred, as a matter of law, the entire and exclusive right, title and interest in the above referenced United States patent application to Xerox.
