CONFIRMATION OF PATENT ASSIGNMENT

THIS DEED is made the _____ day of _____ 2015

BETWEEN KATE SONIA MILLER, an Australian citizen, of 28 Grimsby Street, The Gap, Queensland 4061, Australia ("the Inventor")

AND THE STATE OF QUEENSLAND acting through QUEENSLAND HEALTH ("QH")

AND DTT (HOLDINGS) PTY LTD, ACN 150 216 363 of Level 11, Sherwood House, 39 Sherwood Road, Toowong, QLD 4066, Australia ("the Assignee")

RECITALS

- A. The Inventor is an inventor named in the applications for the grant of a patent set out in the Schedule ("the Patent Applications") in respect of the Invention set out in the Schedule ("the Invention").
- B. The Inventor is, and was at the time of making her inventive contribution to the Invention, an employee of QH, and made the inventive contribution in the course of that employment.
- C. On 5 March 2007, QH entered a professional services agreement with Diversionsary Therapy Technologies Pty Ltd, ACN 122 158 918 (DTT) pursuant to which all intellectual property arising from the work of the Inventor vested in DTT. The Inventor's inventive contribution to the Invention was made pursuant to the professional services agreement.
- D. DTT was the first applicant for the Patent Applications other than US Patent Application no. 13/003,870 (the US Application).
- E. The Inventor was a first co-applicant for the US Application.
- F. DTT has assigned its rights in respect of the Patent Applications to the Assignee.
- G. The Inventor and QH have executed this assignment to confirm that at the date of filing Provisional Patent Application no. 2008903628 (the Filing Date), all rights, title and interest in the Invention had vested in DTT in consideration of the payment of the sum of \$1.00, receipt of which is acknowledged.

ASSIGNMENT

- 1. The Inventor and QH each confirms that, at the Filing Date, the whole of its rights in relation to the Invention throughout the world, including but not

limited to the right to apply for the grant of a patent in respect of the invention in any country of the world, had vested in DTT.

2. For the avoidance of doubt, the inventor assigns to the Assignee any rights she may have in respect of the US Application, including but not limited to the right to claim priority from the US Application in respect of applications made for the grant of a patent anywhere in the world; and the right to bring legal proceedings and to obtain any relief for infringement of a patent granted in respect of the US Application.
3. The inventor and QH each agrees to provide any assistance reasonably required by the Assignee in order to give full effect to this Deed (including but not limited to the execution of any documents). The inventor irrevocably appoints the Assignee as her attorney to do all acts and execute all documents which the inventor is obliged to do or execute by this clause.
4. The Assignee shall be responsible for paying the costs of preparation and execution of this Deed and recordal of the assignment of the Patent Applications, and for any stamp duty payable in respect of this Deed.






