PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This Patent Application Assignment (the "Assignment") is made and effective as of May 10, 2016 ("Effective Date") by and between Noe Sandoval and Karina Lupercio (the "Assignor") and Noe Sandoval (the Assignee). The Assignor and/or the Assignee may be referred to individually as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Assignor(s) have invented certain new and useful inventions (the "Inventions") and (i) have registered or (ii) has applied for the registration of patents application on the Inventions, which patents and applications for patents are listed herein on Schedule 1 and is made a part hereof (collectively, the "Patents"); and

WHEREAS, it is the Assignor's intention to assign and transfer to the Assignee [all of] its right, title and interest in and to the Inventions and the Patents and Patent Applications; and

WHEREAS, the Assignee desires to acquire [all] of the Assignors' right, title and interest in and to the Inventions and the Patent Application; and

WHEREAS, the Contract requires the prior consent of the Assignor; and

WHEREAS, Noe Sandoval and Karina Lupercio ("Assignor") owner of U.S. Patent Application: D752B47, dated April 5, 2016, titled Salon Cape, (the "Patent"). Noe Sandoval ("Assignee") desires to acquire all rights in and to the Patent Application.

NOW THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, the receipt of which is acknowledged, Assignor assigns to Assignee 100% of their rights, title and interest in the invention and Patent Application to Assignee for the entire term of the Patent and Application and

any reissues or extensions and for the entire terms of any patents, reissues or extensions that may issue from foreign applications, divisions, continuations in whole or part or substitute applications filed claiming the benefit of the Patent and Patent Application. The right, title and interest conveyed in this Assignment is to be held and enjoyed by Assignee and Assignee's successors as fully and exclusively as it would have been held and enjoyed by Assignor had this assignment not been made.

Assignor further agrees to: (a) cooperate with Assignee in the protection of the patent rights and prosecution and protection of foreign counterparts; (b) execute, verify, acknowledge and deliver all such further papers, including patent applications and instruments of transfer; and (c) perform such other acts as Assignee lawfully may request to obtain or maintain the Patent and any and all applications and registrations for the invention in any and all countries.

Assignee hereby accepts the assignment of all of Assignors obligations, responsibilities and duties under the Contract and all of Assignor right, title and interest and to the Contract.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Assignor agrees to defend and indemnify the Assignee from any and all claims, actions judgments, liabilities, proceedings and costs resulting from Assignors performance prior to the assignment and resulting from the Assignees performance after the assignment of the Contract, provided however that after the assignment of the Contract the State shall first look to Assignee to satisfy all claims, actions, judgments, liabilities proceedings and costs.

Assignee agrees to indemnify the Assignor from any and all claims, actions, judgments, liabilities, proceedings and costs resulting from Assignees performance after the assignment of the Contract.

This Agreement is governed by the laws of the state of Arizona, without regard to Assignee's conflict or choice of law provisions, and both parties expressly consent to jurisdiction in such courts.

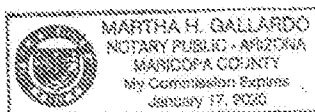
