Dear Sir:

1. I, Annabel Beacham, a European and United Kingdom patent attorney, do hereby declare as follows:

2. Fritz-Frieder Frickel, one of the inventors of the above-captioned application, is now deceased.

3. I confirm that Topivert Pharma Limited, a United Kingdom company, with a place of business at 265 Strand, London, Great Britain, WC2R 1BH, is the owner of any rights of Fritz-Frieder Frickel to the invention that is the subject of the present application by virtue of Section 39(1) of the United Kingdom Patents Act 1977, paragraph (b). That statute provides as follows:

Notwithstanding anything in any rule of law, an invention made by an employee shall, as between him and his employer, be taken to belong to his employer for the purposes of this Act and all other purposes if -

...
(b) the invention was made in the course of the duties of the employee and, at the time of making the invention, because of the nature of his duties and the particular responsibilities arising from the nature of his duties he had a special obligation to further the interests of the employer's undertaking.

4. At the time the present invention was made, Fritz-Frieder Frickel was a director of Topivert Pharma Limited, which is a company that was, at that time, conducting pharmaceutical research on kinase inhibitors. In accordance with the case law in the UK, the nature of the duties of a director and the particular responsibility arising from the nature of these duties meant that Fritz-Frieder Frickel had a "special obligation to further the interests of the [Topivert Pharma Limited]'s undertaking".

5. Accordingly, under Section 39(1) of the United Kingdom Patents Act 1977, paragraph (b), Topivert Pharma Limited is the owner of Fritz-Frieder Frickel's rights in the present invention and the present application.
