ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT RIGHTS

This Assignment of Patent Rights (the "Assignment"), is effective as of July 14, 2016, by and between Terry L. Campbell ("Assignor") and David P. Ouellette ("Assignee").

(1) **Assignment of Patent Rights.** Assignor does hereby transfer, sell, assign, and deliver to Assignee 50% of Assignor's right, title, and interest in and to the invention and Patent described above, for the entire term of the Patent and any reissues or extensions and for the entire terms of any patents, reissues or extensions that may issue from foreign applications, divisions, continuations in whole or part or substitute applications filed claiming the benefit of the Patent, including the right to make, use, and sell the invention described in the Patent in the United States of America and all foreign countries, including the right to claim priority under the laws of the United States, Paris Convention, and any foreign countries. This Assignment includes the right to sue for past and future infringements of, or liabilities for, any of the rights related to the applications or Inventions resulting from the inventions described in the Patent.

(2) **Representations and Warranties.** Assignor hereby represents and warrants to Assignee that Assignor: (i) has all requisite power and authority to enter into this Assignment, and (ii) is transferring to Assignee good and valid title to and beneficial ownership of the inventions described in the Patent.

(3) **Further Assurances.** Assignor and Assignee each agree to perform, execute, acknowledge, and deliver all further transfers, documents, instruments, and assurances as may be necessary or appropriate to effectuate the transaction contemplated by this Assignment.
