WHEREAS, I, Thomas M. PARKS, of 43 Payne Street, Hamilton, New York 13346 U.S.A., have invented certain new and useful improvements in an invention entitled SYSTEM, METHOD AND APPARATUS FOR COMMUNICATION THAT IS INSENSITIVE TO A SAMPLING CLOCK ERROR, for which a provisional patent application was filed on June 14, 2013, and was identified in the United States Patent Office by Application No. 61/835,389, and for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on June 14, 2014, and which may be identified in the United States Patent Office by Application No. 14/304,905.

Upon said consideration I do hereby covenant and agree with the said Assignee, its successors and assigns, that I will not execute in writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with these presents, and that I or my executors or administrators will at any time upon request, without further or additional consideration, but at the expense of the said Assignee, its successors and assigns, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as said Assignee, its successors and assigns, may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United States, or of any and all foreign countries on said invention, and in enforcing any rights occurring as a result of such applications or


patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents.
