**Assignment of Patents, Patent Applications  
& Designs**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made the 1 day of October 2015.

**BETWEEN:**

1. **Reckitt Benckiser N.V.** (a company registered in the Netherlands with number 33287035) whose registered office is at **Siriusdreef 14, 2132 WT Hoofddorp, NETHERLANDS** (the "Assignor"); and
2. **Reckitt Benckiser Finish B.V.** (a company registered in the Netherlands with number 64036030) whose registered office is at **Siriusdreef 14, 2132 WT Hoofddorp, NETHERLANDS** (the "Assignee")

**WHEREAS:**

- (A) The Assignor is the registered proprietor of certain patents and designs, details of which are set out in Schedule 1 (the "Patents").
- (B) Following a legal demerger in which the Assignee acquired all title rights and interests in the patents and, as such, the Assignor has agreed to assign the Patents to the Assignee for due consideration which the Assignee has paid.

**IT IS AGREED as follows:**

1. In consideration of the sum of EUR €1.00 (excluding VAT) now paid to the Assignor the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor as registered proprietor of the Patents and confirmation of previously agreed assignments **HEREBY ASSIGNS absolutely to the Assignee free from encumbrances:-**
  - 1.1. the respective right, title and interest in and to the Patents together with all rights and powers arising or accrued therefrom; and
  - 1.2. the respective right to apply for, prosecute and obtain patent or similar protection in all the countries to which the Patents relate and in respect of the inventions claimed in the Patents including the right to claim priority therefrom to the intent that the grant of any patents, divisionals, continuations including continuations-in-part applications, re-issues or prolongations thereof or similar protection shall be in the name of, and vest in, the Assignee.
2. The Assignor shall, at the request and at the cost of the Assignee, execute any further documents that may be reasonably necessary to secure the vesting in the Assignee of all rights assigned to the Assignee hereunder.
3. This Assignment shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the Laws of the Netherlands.
4. The Assignee, and the Assignee's successors and assigns, are to have, hold, exercise and enjoy the said Patents, including any divisionals, continuations including continuations-in-part applications, re-issues and prolongations thereof or similar protection thereto, with all the rights, powers, privileges and advantages in anyway arising from or pertaining thereto, for and during the term or terms of any such Patents, including any re-issues, divisionals, continuations, including continuations-in-part applications, and prolongations thereof or similar protection thereto, for the use and benefit of said Assignee and said Assignee's successors and assigns, in as ample and beneficial a manner as the said Assignor might or could have held and enjoyed the same, if this Assignment had not been made.

5. The Assignor hereby authorises and requests the Comptroller, Commissioner of Patents or like officer in any country or region in which the Patents are filed to issue a patent as the case may be on any applications, and on any divisionals, continuations including continuations-in-part applications thereof, to the Assignee, and the said Assignee's successors and assigns, in accordance herewith.
