ASSIGNMENT

Anuj K. Sidhu, residing at 4317 Hemingway Drive, Building 26, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49009; Marko N. Kostic, residing at 9965 Sailor Court, Portage, Michigan 49002; Michael Joseph Hayes, residing at 8231 West Q Avenue, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49009; and Kevin Mark Patmore, residing at 19025 N. 19th Street, Plainwell, Michigan 49080 (collectively hereinafter "Assignor") have invented certain new and useful improvements in PERSON SUPPORT APPARATUSES WITH EXIT DETECTION SYSTEMS for which a United States patent application was executed on even date herewith and which claims priority as a continuation-in-part of both U.S. patent application serial number 14/918,003 filed October 20, 2015, and entitled EXIT DETECTION SYSTEM WITH COMPENSATION, and U.S. patent application serial number 14/873,734 filed October 2, 2015, and entitled PERSON SUPPORT APPARATUSES WITH MOTION MONITORING.

Stryker Corporation, a corporation of the State of Michigan, having a place of business at 2825 Airview Boulevard, Kalamazoo, Michigan 49002 (hereinafter referred to as Assignee) desires to acquire the entire right, title, and interest in and to the invention and all patents that may be granted therefor anywhere in the world.

Assignor authorizes and requests the patent office officials in the United States and in all foreign countries to issue all of the patents, when granted, to Assignee as the owner of the entire right, title, and interest in and to the same.

Assignor agrees to communicate to Assignee or its representatives all facts known to Assignor respecting the invention; to testify in all legal proceedings; to sign all documents; to execute all nonprovisional, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, reexamination, substitution, renewal, and extension applications; to execute all necessary assignment documents to cause all of the patents to be issued to Assignee, to make all rightful oaths, and generally to do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for the invention in the United States and in all foreign countries.
