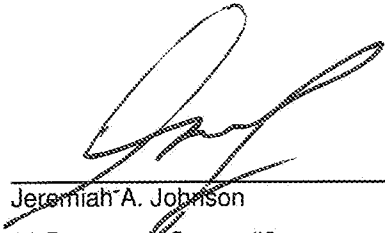
## ASSIGNMENT

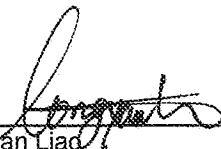

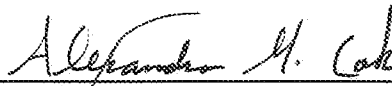

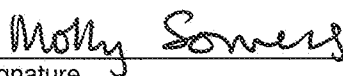
