BETWEEN:

- (1) **BABCOCK INTEGRATED TECHNOLOGY LIMITED**, a limited liability company established under the laws of England and Wales (No. 06717269) and having its registered office at 33 Wigmore Street, London, W1U 1QX, United Kingdom (the "Transferor"); and
- (2) **BABCOCK IP MANAGEMENT (NUMBER ONE) LIMITED**, a limited liability company incorporated in England and Wales (No. 09634332), whose registered office is at 33 Wigmore Street, London, W1U 1QX, United Kingdom (the "Transferee").

RECITALS

- (A) The Transferor is the registered proprietor of patents and has the benefit of certain applications for patents, each of which are set out in the schedule.
- (B) The Transferor wishes to assign to the Transferee the patents and applications set out in the schedule in accordance with the terms set out in this assignment.

THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 The following definition applies in this assignment:

"Patents" means the registered patents and applications for patents set out in the schedule.

- 1.2 Clause and schedule headings do not affect the interpretation of this assignment.

- 1.3 Except where a contrary intention appears, a reference to a clause or schedule is a reference to a clause of, or schedule to this agreement.

- 1.4 Words in the singular include the plural and in the plural include the singular.

- 1.5 A reference to laws in general is to all local, national and directly applicable supra national laws in force for the time being, taking account of any amendment, extension, application or re-enactment and includes any sub-ordinate laws for the time being in force made under them and all orders, notices, codes of practice and guidance made under them.

2. ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

- 2.1 In consideration of the sum of £1 (one pound Sterling) for each patent and patent application in the schedule now paid by the Transferor to the Transferee, receipt of which the Transferor hereby acknowledges, the Transferor hereby assigns: (i) with full title guarantee in respect of the patents set out in Part A of the schedule; and (ii) the bare legal title only in respect of the patent set out in Part B of the schedule, by way of present and future assignment and transfers to the Transferee absolutely (but subject to any existing third party rights):

- (a) all of its right, title and interest in the Patents including all statutory and common law rights, powers, liberties and immunities attaching thereto;
- (b) the right to sue for and to recover damages and other remedies in respect of any past, current and future infringements of the Patents and the right to retain any damages obtained as a result of such action; and

(c) all its right to apply for procure and obtain patent or similar protection throughout the World in respect of the invention claimed in any application including the right to obtain priority therefrom.

2.2 The Transferor shall on written request by the Transferee and at the Transferee's expense do and execute or arrange for the doing and executing of, each act, document and thing reasonably necessary to implement this assignment (including recordal at any relevant registries).

2.3 All payments to be made by the Transferee under this agreement are exclusive of value added tax (if applicable), consumption tax and all other sales taxes or customs duties which shall, where appropriate, be payable in addition, by the Transferee to the Transferor upon receipt of a valid VAT invoice or its equivalent.

3. TERMINATION

The licence agreement relating to the Patents between the parties dated 7 July 2015 is terminated with effect from the date hereof and each party confirms that it has not and is not aware of any outstanding claims and/or rights against the other arising in connection therewith. To the extent that a party thereto has any such rights it unconditionally and irrevocably waives and agrees not to enforce the same.

4. GENERAL

4.1 The Transferor expressly excludes all representations and warranties in respect of the Patents assigned to the Transferee pursuant to this assignment.

4.2 This assignment, together with any documents referred to in it, constitutes the whole agreement between the parties relating to its subject matter and supersedes any prior drafts, agreements, undertakings, representations, warranties and arrangements of any nature, whether in writing or oral, relating to such subject matter.

4.3 No failure to exercise, nor any delay in the exercise, by either party to this assignment of any right, power, privilege or remedy under this assignment shall impair, or operate as a waiver of, such right, power, privilege or remedy.

5. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

5.1 This assignment and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.

5.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this agreement, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
