PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This PATENT ASSIGNMENT (this "<u>Assignment</u>"), dated as of October 3, 2016, is by and between Ball Corporation, an Indiana corporation ("<u>Assignor</u>"), and Independent Can Company, a Maryland corporation ("<u>Assignee</u>").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Ball Aerosol and Specialty Container, Inc., a Delaware corporation, Assignee and Quaker at Todds Lane, LLC, a Maryland limited liability company, have entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement, dated as of September 16, 2016 (the "Purchase Agreement"), pursuant to which, on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in the Purchase Agreement and herein, the parties thereto have agreed that the Assigned Patent will be owned by the Assignee and assigned to the Assignee hereunder; and

WHEREAS, this Assignment is being executed to effect and record the assignment and sale from Assignor to Assignee of the Assigned Patent.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreements and covenants set forth herein, including the consideration set forth in the Purchase Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and such other good and valuable consideration as agreed between Assignor (including its affiliates) and Assignee under separate agreements, Assignor and Assignee hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignment of Assigned Patent.

- (i) Assignor hereby sells, assigns transfers, conveys and delivers to Assignee, and Assignee hereby purchases, acquires and accepts, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Patent set forth on Schedule 1 hereto (the "Assigned Patent"), together with any and all royalties, fees, income, payments and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto and all rights and remedies against past, present, and future infringement or other violation thereof, and all goodwill symbolized by the foregoing.
- (ii) Assignor acknowledges and agrees that Assignee shall have the right to record this Assignment with the United States Patent and Trademark Office or other applicable foreign governmental authority or registrar.
- (iii) This Assignment shall not confer any rights or remedies upon any person or entity other than the parties hereto and their respective successors and permitted assigns. This Assignment may not be amended except by an agreement in writing signed by each of the parties hereto.

2. Further Assurances.

Subject to the Purchase Agreement, in the event that at any time after the date hereof any further action is reasonably necessary to carry out the purposes of this Assignment, each of the parties hereto shall take such further action (including the execution and delivery of such further

instruments and documents) as the other party may reasonably request, at the sole cost and expense of the requesting party.

3. Subject to Purchase Agreement.

The parties hereto acknowledge and agree that the representations, warranties, covenants, agreements and indemnities contained in the Purchase Agreement shall not be superseded hereby but shall remain in full force and effect to the full extent provided therein. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between the terms of the Purchase Agreement and the terms hereof, the terms of the Purchase Agreement shall govern.

4. Miscellaneous.

This Agreement is executed by the Assignor and Assignee and shall be binding upon such parties effective immediately upon the Closing Date. This Agreement shall be subject to all applicable provisions of Article XII (Miscellaneous) of the Purchase Agreement.


