



3. Employee further agrees that he will not at any time hereafter disclose or use any of the Company's confidential or proprietary information unless such information has first been published by the Company or unless Employee has first obtained the written consent of the Company, over the signature of an authorized executive officer of the Company, to make such disclosure. Employee further agrees that all writings, illustrations, models, and other such materials produced by him or put into his possession by the Company during the term of and relating to his employment are at all times the sole exclusive property of the Company, and that he will deliver the same over to the Company upon request by it or upon termination of his employment.
