Thank you for your collaboration with our office in disclosing your invention, INV-1122, entitled, Caged Bags of Porous Materials (the "Invention").


After careful consideration, analysis and deliberation of the patentability and commercial viability of your Invention, Northeastern University has decided not to pursue further protection of any patent, copyright or other intellectual property right to the Invention at its present stage. Accordingly, subject to the provisions of this letter, Northeastern University hereby assigns and releases to you, the inventor, its rights, title and interest in and to the Invention, in accordance with the policies and procedures providing for this assignment and release in the Faculty Handbook (the "Handbook"). If, according to our disclosure records, there is more than one inventor for this Invention, we hereby assign to each inventor via this letter his or her original joint undivided interest in the Invention. In other words, by virtue of this letter the interest each inventor originally assigned to the University is hereby assigned and released to such inventor.

If, according to our disclosure records, more than one person is listed as an inventor, this letter is addressed to each inventor. You have a continuing obligation as stated in the Handbook to disclose to the University any further developments or improvements to the Invention. If this Invention was funded in whole or in part with government support (e.g. a government grant), the government has certain rights to the Invention, potentially including ownership rights. Should you choose to pursue further this Invention on your own, you must comply with any funding guidelines as set by the funding agency, including, if required, petitioning the government to have title to the Invention exclusively revert to you (and any other inventors).

You may now pursue this Invention on your own and we wish you the best should you choose to do so.
