1. The Course of the Proceedings

This is found in the following items:

- the record of the session on 2 September 2014.

2. The Petition

The petitioner is asking to be declared to be in a state of bankruptcy at its own request.

3. Judgement

From the findings of fact and conclusions of law, it appears in summary that the debtors have come to a point where they have ceased to pay;

Based on Art. 1, 2, 4, 6, and 14 of the Bankruptcy Law;

In accordance with Art. 3, item 1, of Order 1346/2000 of the Council of the European Union, the court is authorized to initiate these insolvency proceedings now that it has been satisfactorily determined that the center of the primary interest of the petitioner is located in The Netherlands.

4. The Decision

The court:

Hereby declares that Ingely PCR B.V. is in a state of bankruptcy;

And appoints Mr. E.A.M. Raaijmakers-Rottier, a member of this bench, as examining magistrate and hereby engages Mr. F.T. Hiemstra, attorney of Middelberg, as receiver;

Directs that the receiver alone shall have responsibility for reporting to the examining magistrate and that, effective as of this date, all interested parties shall deal exclusively with the Court of Zeeland-West-Brabant, Breda office, and the above-mentioned examining magistrate in Breda;

Authorizes the receiver to open letters and telegrams addressed to the party in bankruptcy.

This ruling is handed down by Mr. E.K. van der Lende-Mulder Smit and is issued in an open session of the court on 2 September 2014 at 1430 hours, in the presence of M. E. van Dijk as clerk.

benoemt tot rechter-commissaris het lid van deze rechbank mr. E.A.M. Raaijmakers-


Rottier en stelt aan tot curator mr. F.T. Hiemstra, advocaat te Middelburg;

3. Time limits (Rule 142(4) EPC)

3.1 The time limits in force as regards the applicant for or proprietor of the patent at the date of interruption of the proceedings begin again as from the day on which the proceedings are resumed, with the following two exceptions:

3.1.1 Time limit for the request for examination and paying the examination fee, Rule 70(1) EPC)

The interrupted time limit continues to run as from the day on which proceedings are resumed, but only for the remaining period (J 07/83, OJ EPO 1984, 211). If such date is less than two months before the end of the period within which the request for examination must be filed, such a request may be filed up to the end of two months after such date (Rule 142(4) EPC).

3.1.2 Time limit for payment of renewal fees and also payment of the surcharge for the renewal fees under Rule 51 EPC

Renewal fees which would have fallen due in the period between the day on which proceedings are interrupted and the day before they are resumed fall due on the day of resumption (J 1/87, OJ EPO 1988, 323). For such fees the full six-month period under Rule 51(2) EPC therefore begins to run on the day after proceedings are resumed.

If the six-month time limit provided for in Rule 51(2) EPC is already in force at the date of interruption, the interrupted time limit continues to run as from the day on which proceedings are resumed, but only for the remaining period.

3.2 Communications and decisions from the EPO sent in the period between the day on which proceedings are interrupted and the day they are resumed are considered as null and void and will be dispatched anew after the resumption of proceedings from the competent departments entrusted with the procedure.

3.3 Please be aware that automatic debit orders do however cease to be effective if the grant proceedings are interrupted under Rule 142 EPC (See Point 13.1(f) of the Arrangements for the automatic debiting procedure, Annex A. 1 to the Arrangements for deposit accounts (Supplementary publication, OJ EPO 3, 2015)). If, when the proceedings are resumed, the automatic debiting procedure is to be used again, a new automatic debit order must be issued.

4. Right to be heard (Art. 113 EPC)

Should you have any objections to these findings of the Legal Division, you are invited to file your comments within two months from the date of notification of this communication.

5. Responsibility
