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ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS

This Assignment of Patents is made effective as of January 13, 2017, by Curelon, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "ASSIGNOR"), to and for the benefit of Galenagen, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company with offices at 411 Theodore Fremd Avenue, Suite 206, Rye, New York 10580, and its successors and assigns (the "ASSIGNEE").

WHEREAS, the ASSIGNOR has agreed to sell and ASSIGNEE has agreed to purchase certain assets of the ASSIGNOR pursuant to an Asset Purchase Agreement by and among the ASSIGNOR and the ASSIGNEE dated of even date herewith (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"); and

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration received pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, ASSIGNOR hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, the entire right, title and interest in and throughout the United States of America (including its territories and dependencies) and all countries foreign thereto, in and to and under said Patents and any and all inventions described and/or claimed therein and any and all patents and like rights of exclusion (including reissue, reexamination or extensions thereof) of any country which may be granted on or for said inventions or on any counterpart, divisional, substitution, continuation, continuation-in-part, or other patent application based on said Patents, the same to be held and enjoyed by the ASSIGNEE for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR if this assignment had not been made, together with (a) all rights to receive royalties, fees, income, payments, and other proceeds now or hereafter due or payable with respect to any and all of the foregoing, and (b) all claims and causes of action with respect to any of the foregoing, whether accruing before, on, or after the date hereof, including, without limitation, all rights to and claims for damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal and equitable relief for or by reason of past, present or future infringement of said Patents or said inventions or misuse, misappropriation or theft of any of said inventions, and (c) the right to sue for and collect such damages, restitution, and injunctive and other legal or equitable relief for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.

ASSIGNOR hereby covenants and agrees to cooperate with said ASSIGNEE to enable said ASSIGNEE to enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interest herein conveyed in the United States, foreign countries, or under any international convention, agreement, protocol, or treaty. Such cooperation by the ASSIGNOR shall include prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving of testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by the parties (a) for perfecting in said Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any of

said applications covering said Inventions; (c) for filing and prosecuting substitute, divisional, continuing or additional applications covering said Inventions; (d) for filing and prosecuting applications for reissuance of any said Patent(s); (e) for interference or other priority proceedings involving said Inventions; and (f) for legal proceedings involving said Inventions and any applications therefor and any Patent(s) granted thereon, including without limitation reissues and reexaminations, opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions.

ASSIGNOR also hereby sells, assigns and transfers unto the ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, all of its rights under the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and all other treaties of like purpose in respect of each and all of said Patents and said inventions and any other patents issued thereon.

ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes the ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives to apply in its or their own name or names for patents and like rights of exclusion on or for said inventions or any of them or any part thereof in all countries, claiming if it or they so desire the priority of the filing date under the provisions of said Convention and all such other treaties of like purpose. Assignor further authorizes the Commissioner for Patents in the United States Patent and Trademark Office and the officials of corresponding entities or agencies in any other applicable jurisdictions to record and register this Patent Assignment upon request by Assignee.

ASSIGNOR hereby request that any Patent(s) issuing in the United States, foreign countries, or under any international convention, agreement, protocol, or treaty, be issued in the name of the ASSIGNEE, or its successors and assigns, for the sole use of said ASSIGNEE its successors, legal representatives and assigns.

This Assignment of Patents is delivered pursuant to, and subject to, the terms and conditions of the Asset Purchase Agreement. Nothing contained in this Assignment of Patents shall be deemed to supersede any of the representations, warranties, covenants or other agreements contained in the Asset Purchase Agreement or otherwise expand any of the rights or remedies of the ASSIGNEE with respect to the transactions contemplated thereby. To the extent any of the provisions in this Assignment of Patents are inconsistent with the Asset Purchase Agreement, the Asset Purchase Agreement shall control.






